DEEP DRAWERS


"We are putting more items below the counter, including glasses and dishes," says Jean Stoffer. "It's great for aging in place, too."





FULL OVERLAY "When doors and drawers completely cover the cabinetry face, it offers a streamlined aesthetic," Stoffer says. Plus, you'll gain an inch of space inside.



PARTIAL OVERLAY The doors sit on top of the frame, revealing a gap. They're the only kind you can open without hardware, and often the least-expensive option.



INSET With a frame construction as opposed to frameless, which is more typical of European models-cabinet doors can be inset so they're flush with the frame.



Beaded? Beveled? Reeded? There are myriad cabinet options, but the most popular is **Shaker:** Its minimal design means it works with virtually every style.
