


## MINI FPP SPARROWS BLOCK:

PRINT THIS PAGE AT 100% OR "DO NOT SCALE". ONE COPY OF THIS PAGE WILL MAKE ONE SPARROWS BLOCK.







- 1. Print the paper piecing pattern at 100% or "Do Not Scale" and cut out 1/8" 1/4" past the outer edge of the pattern.
- 2. Adjust the stitch length on your sewing machine to 1.4 1.6.
- 3. Starting with Section 1, place the Section 1 fabric right side facing up, centered on the wrong side of pattern.
- 4. Place the Section 2 fabric on top of Section 1 fabric, RST. Hold up the pattern and fabrics to a light source to ensure everything is lined up properly.
- 5. Sew along the line between Sections 1 and 2. Fold back the paper along stitched line and trim 1/4" away from the folded edge.
- 6. Repeat with remaining the numbered sections, if applicable. Trim the fabric so it lines up with the outer edge of the pattern.
- 7. Carefully tear away the paper on the backside of the block.
- 8. Using a 1/4" seam allowance, sew units A C, RST, as illustrated.

The Mini Sparrows Block will measure  $31/2" \times 57/8"$  finished  $(4" \times 63/8"$  unfinished)
