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3 Wishes Fabric * World of Wonder

- 1 Panel - Panel (18689-PNL-CTN-D)
- 3/4 yard - Floral (18685-GRN-CTN-D)
- 5/8 yard - Unicorn (18686-LIL-CTN-D)
- \(1 / 2\) yard - Strands (18690-MLT-CTN-D)
- \(1 / 2\) yard - Wings (18691-MLT-CTN-D) for Binding
- 1/3 yard - Lion (18683-GLD-CTN-D)
- \(23 / 4\) yards - Bubbles (18687-BLU-CTN-D) for Backing
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## Additional Supplies Needed:

- 55 in x 63 in ( $139.7 \mathrm{~cm} \times 160.02 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Cotton batting
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)


## Befare Yau Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof $=$ width of fabric

Note: A printed panel may become slightly skewed during the finishing process. Check if panel is square before cutting by folding the panel so selvages meet. If all edges do not meet, pull firmly from corner to corner until the edges meet. Continue until all corners are square.

## Cutting

Use a rotary cutter and ruler to cut the size and number of squares and rectangles from each fabric listed below.


Panel (18689-PNL-CTN-D) - 1 panel
Fussy Cut $1-321 / 2$ in $\times 401 / 2$ in ( $82.55 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ )


## Floral (18685-GRN-CTN-D) - $3 / 4$ yard

Cut 4-2 $1 / 2$ in $\times 30 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 77.47 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut 4-2 $1 / 2$ in $\times 221 / 2$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 57.15 \mathrm{~cm})$


Unicorn (18686-LIL-CTN-D) - 5/8 yard
Cut 2-2 $1 / 2$ in $\times 301 / 2$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 77.47 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut 2-2 $1 / 2$ in $\times 221 / 2$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 57.15 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut 24-2 $1 / 2$ in $\times 21 / 2$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut 8 - 3 in $\times 3$ in ( $7.62 \mathrm{~cm} \times 7.62 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) - Makes 16 Half-Square Triangles


Strands (18690-MLT-CTN-D) - $1 / 2$ yard
Cut $16-21 / 2$ in $\times 61 / 2$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut 16-2 $1 / 2$ in $\times 2^{1 / 2}$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut 8-3 in x 3 in ( $7.62 \mathrm{~cm} \times 7.62 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) - Makes 16 Half-Square Triangles

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Wings (18691-MLT-CTN-D) - $1 / 2$ yard
Cut 6-2 $1 / 2$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm}) \mathrm{x}$ wof


Lion (18683-GLD-CTN-D) - $1 / 3$ yard
Cut 2-1 $1 / 2$ in $\times 401 / 2$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut 2-1 $1 / 2$ in $\times 341 / 2$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 87.63 \mathrm{~cm})$
Fussy Cut 4 Lion Heads - $21 / 2$ in $\times 21 / 2$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$

## Sewing

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a Unicorn square 3 in $\times 3$ in $(7.62 \mathrm{~cm} \times 7.62 \mathrm{~cm})$ as shown in Diagram A. Place on top of a Strands square 3 in $\times 3$ in ( $7.62 \mathrm{~cm} \times 7.62 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) RST and sew $1 / 4$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ away from the line on both sides. Cut on the drawn line; press. Two squares yield two Half-Square Triangle Units. Repeat to make a total of 16 Half-Square Triangle Units $21 / 2$ in $\times 21 / 2$ in ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 6.35 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Trim if necessary.

2. Place one Lion, four Unicorn squares, and four Half-Square Triangle Units $21 / 2$ in $\times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$ in three rows as shown in Diagram B. Pin the pieces in each row RST, sew and press. Pin the rows RST matching seams, sew and press to make a Friendship Star Block $61 / 2$ in $\times 61 / 2$ in $(16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$. Make four.

3. Place a Strands square $2 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 21 / 2$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$ on each side of a Unicorn square $21 / 2$ in $\times 21 / 2$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$ as shown in Diagram C. Note: Check the direction of the design. Pin RST, sew and press. Place a Strands rectangle $21 / 2$ in $\times 61 / 2$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$ on the top and bottom. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Square-in-a-Square Block finishing at $61 / 2$ in $\times 6 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Make eight.

4. Place a Floral rectangle $21 / 2$ in $\times 221 / 2$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 57.15 \mathrm{~cm})$ on each side of a Unicorn rectangle $2 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 22 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 57.15 \mathrm{~cm})$ as shown in Diagram D. Pin RST, sew and press to make Border Unit A finishing at $61 / 2$ in $\times 221 / 2 \mathrm{in}(16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 57.15 \mathrm{~cm})$. Repeat to make two.

5. Place a Floral rectangle $21 / 2$ in $\times 30 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 77.47 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on each side of a Unicorn rectangle $21 / 2$ in $\times 301 / 2$ in ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 77.47 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram E. Pin RST, sew and press to make Border Unit B finishing at $61 / 2$ in $\times 301 / 2 \mathrm{in}(16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 77.47 \mathrm{~cm})$. Make two.

6. Place a Friendship Star Block and a Square-in-a-Square Block $61 / 2$ in $\times 61 / 2$ in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on each end of Border Unit A $61 / 2$ in $\times 221 / 2$ in $(16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 57.15 \mathrm{~cm})$ as shown in Diagram F, aligning the seams as shown. Pin, sew and press to make the Top Border finishing at $61 / 2$ in $\times 461 / 2$ in $(16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 118.11 \mathrm{~cm})$. Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

7. Place a Square-in-a-Square Block $6 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 6 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on each end of a Border Unit B $61 / 2$ in $\times 301 / 2$ in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 77.47 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram G, aligning the seams as shown. Pin, sew and press to make the Side Border $6 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 42 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Repeat to make two.

8. Refer to Diagram H to finish the Quilt Top. Place a Lion strip $11 / 2$ in $\times 401 / 2 \mathrm{in}(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm})$ on each side of the Fussy Cut Panel rectangle $321 / 2$ in $\times 401 / 2$ in ( $82.55 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Pin RST matching ends and middles; sew and press. Place a Lion strip $11 / 2$ in $\times 341 / 2$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 87.63 \mathrm{~cm})$ on the top and bottom. Pin RST matching ends and middles, sew and press to measure $341 / 2$ in $\times 41 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $87.63 \mathrm{~cm} \times 105.41 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Note: Check orientation of designs.
Place Side Borders $61 / 2$ in $\times 421 / 2$ in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown. Pin RST; sew and press. Place Top and Bottom Borders $61 / 2$ in $\times 461 / 2$ in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 118.11 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown on the top and bottom. Pin RST; sew and press. Note: Check orientation of designs.
The Quilt Top should measure 46 ½ in $\times 541 / 2$ in $(118.11 \mathrm{~cm} \times 138.43 \mathrm{~cm})$.

## Finishing

9. Remove the selvages from the Bubbles Backing fabric. Note: Check orientation of design. Cut one piece $401 / 4 \mathrm{in} \times 63$ in $(102.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times 160.02 \mathrm{~cm})$ and two pieces $15 \frac{1}{4}$ in $\times 31 \frac{3}{4}$ in ( $38.74 \mathrm{~cm} \times 80.65 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Pin RST and sew the two smaller pieces on the short edges; press. Pin the two sections RST and sew along the long edges as shown in Diagram I. Press the seam open or to one side. The Backing should measure 55 in x 63 in ( $139.7 \mathrm{~cm} \times 160.02 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).


Bubbles - $23 / 4$ yard
Cut $1-40 \frac{1}{4}$ in $\times 63$ in ( $102.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times 160.02 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut 2-15 $1 / 4$ in $\times 313 / 4$ in ( $38.74 \mathrm{~cm} \times 80.65 \mathrm{~cm}$ )


55 in $\times 63$ in ( $139.7 \mathrm{~cm} \times 160.02 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
10. Press finished Quilt Top and Backing. Tape the Backing, wrong side up, to a firm surface. Layer Batting and Quilt Top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
11. Once quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and Batting even with the Quilt Top.
12. Binding - Follow Diagram J to make the Binding from the Wings print. Remove selvages and sew the short ends of the five $21 / 2$ in x wof ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ wof) strips RST end to end at a $45^{\circ}$ angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end $1 / 4$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ to the wrong side. Fold in half lengthwise with wrong sides together; press. Leaving a 2 in ( 5.08 cm ) tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Quilt Top and sew, mitering the corners. Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold Binding over to back and hand stitch.

## Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. Tip: Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
