Description: This is the perfect Caddy to hold all your sewing supplies for class. This easy to carry container will hold all your sewing tools or make one for a friend to carry all their art or beauty supplies.

Prior To Class Purchase The Following:

½ Yard Fabric (Home Dec, Denim, or Pre-Quilted)

*** If you are using cotton quilting fabric, use a light weight or Medium weight interfacing for each piece. If you want to prequilt your fabric; ½ yd of fabric, ½ yd batting, and ½ yard lining.

30" or longer zipper (*Please don't use the YKK Plastic Zippers- you can't sew through the teeth*) ByAnnie Zippers work great!

Thread to match

2 ½ yards webbing for handles

Basic sewing supplies: Matching Thread, seam ripper, scissors, extra needles, Chalk, marking pens/pencils, Rotary Cutter, Clips

Prior to Class: Cut the following:

Sides and Top: (1) 31" x 8 ¾"

Front: (1) 12" x 7 ¾"

Back: (1) 12 x 7 ¾"

Bottom: (1) 8 ¾" x 7 ¾"

Inside front lining (1) 12" x 8" This is optional with quilted fabrics

Optional Back Pocket – to carry your Ruler (1) 9" x 7 ¾"

Class Policy

A minimum of 4 students is needed to make a class a "go". If a class fails to register 4 students you will receive a full refund.

Please purchase all class supplies prior to first class (unless otherwise noted).
