





Table Topper Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Santa Block Panel - Red (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 16" x 19" rectangle centered on the large block.

From the Folio - Forest (B), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 ½" x 19" strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 ½" x 20" strips.

From the Border Stripe - Cream (C), cut:

- (2) 8 ½" x 21 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 8 ½" x 18 ½" LOF strips.

From the Allover Ornaments - Black (D), cut:

• (1) 8 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 8 ½" squares.

From the Plaid - Red (E), cut:

- (4) 2" x 37 ½" WOF strips.
- (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Holly Leaf and Berry - Cream (F), cut:

- (2) 4 ½" x 40 ½" WOF strips.
- (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 45 ½" strips.


From the Poinsettia Print - Cream (Backing), cut:

• (2) 53" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 53" x 56" back.

Table Topper Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 19" Fabric B strip to each side of the 16" x 19" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 20" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure 18 ½" x 21 ½".



- 2. Sew (1) 8 ½" x 21 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 8 ½" Fabric D square to each end of (1) 8 ½" x 18 ½" Fabric C strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block (Fig. 2 on page 2).
- 3. Sew (1) 2" x 37 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 37 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block (Fig. 2 on page 2).
- 4. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 45 ½" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the Topper top (Fig. 2 on page 2).

- 5. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 6. Sew the (5) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and
- 7. Bind as desired.



Place Mat Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Santa Block Panel - Red (A):

• Fussy cut (4) 9 ½" squares, each centered on a small block.

From the Folio - Forest (B), cut:

- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 9 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 11 ½" strips.

From the Plaid - Red (C), cut:

- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 10 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Allover Ornaments - Black (D), cut:


• (1) 12 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 12 ½" x 3" strips.

From the Holly Leaf and Berry - Cream (Backing), cut:

• (2) 16" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 16" x 21" rectangles.

Place Mat Assembly

1. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 9 ½" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 11 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 3). Trim the unit to measure 10 ½" x 10 ½". Repeat to make (4) Unit 1 squares total.



2. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (4) Unit 2 squares total.




3. Sew (1) 3" x 12 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 square to make (1) Place Mat top (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (4) Place Mat tops total.



- 4. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 5. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Cut the strip into (4) equal pieces.
- 6. Bind as desired.
