



**Class: Fabric Cheat Sheet Workshop**

**Description:** In this class you will receive a fabric cutting kit. You will learn the difference between using the Fabric Blade and the Rotary Blade, including ways to stabilize your fabric. With the help of the provided Fabric cheat sheet, you can easily note the best cut settings and mat to use to cut your materials. This cheat sheet is a valuable resource for both classroom and home use, as it simplifies the process of cutting fabric.

SNC Machine and basic accessories

Rotary Blade (Turquoise)Required

Fabric Blade (Gold)(if you don't own it, you may borrow mine)

Low, Standard and Fabric Cutting Mat(you can borrow my fabric mat if needed)

1" or ¾" Scotch Multi-Purpose Blue Painters Tape and/or Nova ¼" Tape

Grocery bag for Trash - bring to all SNC Classes
