

Class: Beginner Foundation Paper Piecing **

Instructor: Mary-Jeanine Ibarguen

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Description: Foundation paper piecing (FPP), which is sewing fabric onto a paper pattern, allows you to get perfect points that match every time. Learn some great tips and techniques from Mary-Jeanine so that you confidently pick up any paper pieced pattern and know just how to make it. You will get 5 copies of the block, so you can make more copies if you want to make something larger than our little wallhanging.

Note: There is no pattern to purchase. Mary-Jeanine has designed a simple flower block and will bring copies for you.

Supplies To Bring To Class:

Fabrics:

- 2 green fat quarters for the leaves
- 1 pink, purple, yellow or some other flower colored fat quarter
- 1/2 yard light blue or other background color

Supplies:

- Fabric and paper scissors
- regular sewing supplies (snips, pins, seam ripper, etc)
- Size 80 Sharps needle for piecing.
- Medium grey cotton thread for piecing
- Rotary Cutter and ruler (6" x 24" if you have it)

Class Policy

A minimum of 4 students is needed to make a class a "go". If a class fails to register 4 students you will receive a full refund.
