

Class: MJ's Tshirt Quilt Top \*\*

**Description**: Learn a completely different way to make a T-shirt quilt! Instead of cutting all shirts to the same size square, sewing on sashing and borders, this technique allows you to use any size and part of the tshirt. Mary-Jeanine will guide you toward making a simple 'background' and then cutting and fusing the shirts over the top of that.

## **Supplies To Purchase/Bring To Class:**

<u>Fabrics:</u> to make this 72" x 84" sized quilt, you will need (refer to photo on class description)

Fabric 1: 3.5 yardsFabric 2: 2.25 yards

## Supplies:

- Applique Pressing Sheet (BTD206)
- EZ-Steam II fusible tape, ½" wide (EZ2-20T)
- Optional: you may outline/frame each shirt with thin contrasting ribbon or braid
- regular sewing supplies (snips, pins, seam ripper, etc)
- thread for piecing, recommend medium grev color
- Rotary Cutter (bring a backup blade!)
- If you have a large square ruler (9" or larger), please bring it
- If you're buying pins, please don't buy the "Quilting Pins" with the big yellow heads. Look for Clover "Silk Pins Boxed" (Art No.2501) They are the **best!**

## **Class Policy**

A minimum of 4 students is needed to make a class a "go". If a class fails to register 4 students you will receive a full refund.

All students get a **15%** discount on all class supplies purchased at <u>The Sewing Studio</u> <u>Fabric Superstore.</u>

Please purchase all class supplies prior to first class (unless otherwise noted).
