Using a ready-made design, you'll cut and press your chosen fabrics onto a tote bag, turning it into a bright and beautiful accessory perfect for sunny days and adventures.

Supply List:

Approximate size, do not precut fabric:

3 - 8" x 8" different colors of cotton or batik fabric (see website picture for ideas of colors)

3 - 8" x 8" Heat N Bond Ultra

Tote bag (Length: 13 1/4" x Width: 13 1/4" or bigger)

ScanNCut and all accessories that came with machine

Laptop and mouse

Rotary Auto Blade or Fabric Blade

All cutting mats

Laptop and mouse required (mac owners need to know how to use their computer)

Brayer Tool (optional)

Blue Painters Tape/Nova Tape

Grocery bag for Trash - bring to all SNC Classes
