## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Sewing/Knitting Notions - White (A), cut:

- (1) $51 / 4 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $51 / 4 "$ squares, (2) $31 / 2 "$ squares, and (4) $21 / 2 "$ squares.


## From the Buttons - Pink (B), cut:

- (1) $71 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $71 / 2 " \times 2$ " strips (Template 3), (2) $61 / 2 " \times 2 "$ strips (Template 4), (2) $51 / 2 " \times 21 / 2 "$ strips (Template 3), (2) $51 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ (Template 4), (4) $5 " \times 2 "$ strips (Template 2), (2) $4 " \times 11 / 2 "$ strips (Template 1), and (2) $4 " \times 21 / 2 "$ strips (Template 1).


## From the Scissors - White on White (C), cut:

-(3) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times 561 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times 511 / 2 "$ strips.

- For Block 1:
- (1) 3 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 3 " squares (Template 1),
(2) 3 " $\times 71 / 2 "$ strips (Template 3), (2) 3 " $\times 6$ " strips (Template 4), and (2) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ ( Template 2).
- (1) $8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $8 " \times 9 "$ strips and (2) $4 \frac{1}{2} / " \times 9 "$ strips.
-(1) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $31 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips and (2) $31 / 2 " \times 8$ " strips.


## - For Block 3 \& Block 5:

- (1) $6^{1 / 2 "} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $61 / 2 " \times 51 / 2 "$ strips and (4) 4 " squares (Template 11).
- (1) 6 " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 " x $61 / 2 "$ strips.
-(1) 5 " WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 " $\times 51 / 2 "$ strips and
(4) 4 " squares (Template 12).
- (1) 5 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 " x 6 " strips.
- (1) 4 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $4^{" \prime} \times 5^{1 / 2 "}$ strips (Template 9) and (4) 4" squares (Template 10).

From the Pins \& Needles - White (D), cut:

- Block 2 \& Block 4:
- (1) 6 " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 " 5 " strips (Template 5) and (4) 6 " $\times 4$ " strips (Template 6).
- (1) 6 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 " x $41 / 2 "$ strips (Template 7) and (4) $51 / 2 "$ squares (Template 8).
- (1) 5 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 " x $51 / 4 "$ strips and (4) $5 " \times 4 \frac{1}{2} "$ strips.
- (1) $43 / 4 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $43 / 4 " x 51 / 4 "$ strips and (4) $41 / 2 " \times 43 / 4 "$ strips.
- Block 6:
-(1) 8 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 8 " x 9 " strips and
(2) $8 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strips and
(2) $41 / 2 " \times 9 "$ strips.
- (1) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $31 / 2 " \times 21 / 2 "$ strips (Template 2), (2) 3 " $\times 71 / 2 "$ strips (Template 3 ) and (2) 3 " $\times 6$ " strips (Template 4), and (2) 3 " squares (Template 1).

From the Pin Circles - Charcoal (E), cut:

- (1) 6 " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6 " x 3 " strips (Template 5),
(2) $6 " \times 4 "$ strips (Template 6), (2) $5 " \times 2 "$ strips (Template 6), and (2) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 "$ strips (Template 5).
-(1) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $51 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strips (Template 8), (2) $5 " \times 3 "$ strips (Template 7), (2) $5 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strips (Template 7), and (2) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2 "$ strips (Template 8).

From the Pins \& Needles - Charcoal (F), cut:

- (1) $51 / 4 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $5^{1 / 4} / 4$ squares and (2) $31 / 2 /$ " squares.
- (4) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 641 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 53 "$ strips.
-(3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 541 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 43 "$ strips.
-(6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Stacked Thread Spools - White (G), cut:
- (1) 7 " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 7 " $\times 21 / 1 / 2 "$ strips (Template 9),
(2) $51 / 2 " \times 3 "$ strips (Template 10), (2) $5 " \times 21 / 2 "$ strips (Template 9), (2) 5 " $\times 21 / 2 "($ Template 10), (2) $5 " \times 3 "$ (Template 11) and (2) 4 " $\times 21 / 2 "$ strips (Template 11).
- (1) 3 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 3 " x 5 " strips (Template 12) and (2) 3 " $\times 6$ " strips (Template 12).

From the Sewing Machines - White (H), cut:

- (1) 6 " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $6 " \times 3 "$ strips (Template 5),
(2) $6 " \times 4$ " strips (Template 6), (2) $5 " \times 2$ " strips (Template 6),
(2) $5 " \times 3 "$ (Template 7), and (2) $41 / 2 " \times 4 "$ strips (Template 5).
- (1) $3^{1 / 2 " x} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $3^{1 / 2 "} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ strips (Template 7),
(2) $31 / 2 " \times 51 / 2 "$ strips (Template 8), and (2) $31 / 2 " \times 3 "$ strips
(Template 8).

## Cutting Instructions - Continued

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Pin Cushions - White (I), cut:
-(1) 7 "x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $7 " \times 21 / 2 "$ strips (Template 9),
(2) $6 " \mathrm{x} 3 "$ strips (Template 12), (2) $51 / 2 " \times 3 "$ strips (Template 10),
(2) $5 " \times 21 / 2 "$ strips (Template 9), (2) $5 " \times 21 / 2 "$ strips (Template 10),
(2) $5 " \times 3 "$ strips (Template 11), (2) $5 " \times 3 "$ strips (Template 12),
(2) $4 " \times 21 / 2 "$ strips (Template 11).

From the Ric-Rac Stripe - Red (J), cut:
-(1) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $51 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips (Template 4), (2) $51 / 2 " \times 21 / 2 "$ strips (Template 3), (4) 5 " $\times 2 "$ strips (Template 2), (2) $4 " \times 21 / 2 "$ strips (Template 1) and
(2) $4 " \times 1 \frac{1}{2} "$ strips (Template 1).

- (1) $2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $2 " \times 71 / 2 "$ strips (Template 3) and (2) $2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips (Template 4).

From the Yarn Spools - Pink (Backing), cut:
-(2) $61 " x$ WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $61 " \mathrm{x} 74 "$ back.

## Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Using your favorite paper-piecing method, refer to Figure 1 and Template 1 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Unit 1 strips.
2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 2 and Template 2 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Unit 2 strips.
3. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 3 and Template 3 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make
(2) $21 / 2 " \times 9$ " Unit 3 strips.
4. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 4 and Template 4 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2) $21 / 2 " \times 8 "$ Unit 4 strips.

7. Sew together (1) $31 / 2 " \times 8 "$ Fabric C strip, (1) Unit 4 strip and (1) 9 " $\times 8$ " Fabric C strip, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row (Fig. 5).
8. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 5-7 lengthwise to make (1) 14 " Block One square (Fig. 5).
9. Repeat Steps 5-8 to make a second Block One square.

Quilt Top Assembly (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 58. Sew (1) $11 / 2$ " $\times 541 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 43 "$ Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
59. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 561 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 511 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
60. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 641 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 53 "$ Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
61. Layer and quilt as desired.
62. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric F strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
63. Bind as desired.
