Fabric B: GHTF 4704 R	2 panels
Fabric C: GHTF 4707 R	1 1/4 yards
Fabric D: GHTF 4707 W	1 1/2 yards
Fabric E: GHTF 4709 G	1 3/8 yards
Fabric F: GHTF 4709 R	1 1/2 yards
Fabric G: SUES 299 Y	Fat Eighth
Backing: GHTF 4708 R suggested	4 1/2 yards
Batting:	80" x 80"

Additional supplies: Paper-backed fusible web for appliqué

Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvages) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

From Fabric A:

1. Cut large square 18 1/2" x 18 1/2" centering design. (Center Block)
2. Cut small squares 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" centering design in each block. (Block B)

From Fabric B:

1. Cut four 14 1/2" x 14 1/2" squares centering round design within each one. (Block A)

From Fabric C:

1. Cut eight 4 1/2" strips. Sew strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Press seams open. From this pieced strip, cut two 4 1/2" x 64 1/2" strips and two 4 1/2" x 72 1/2" strips. (Outer Border)

From Fabric D:

1. Cut seven 1 1/2" strips. Sew strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Press seams open. From this pieced strip, cut two 1 1/2" x 60 1/2" strips and two 1 1/2" x 62 1/2" strips. (Inner Border)
2. Cut two 1 1/2" strips; subcut two 18 1/2" strips and two 20 1/2" strips. (Center Block)
3. Cut three 10 7/8" strips; subcut eight 10 7/8" squares. Cut each square diagonally in half to yield sixteen half-square triangles. (Block B)

From Fabric E:

1. Cut seven 1 1/2" strips. Sew strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Press seams open. From this pieced strip, cut two 1 1/2" x 62 1/2" strips and two 1 1/2" x 64 1/2" strips. (Middle Border)

2. Cut eight 1 1/2" strips; subcut eight 1 1/2" x 18 1/2" strips and eight 1 1/2" x 20 1/2" strips. (Block A)
3. Cut eight 2 1/2" strips. (Binding)

From Fabric F:

1. Cut eight 2 1/2" strips; subcut eight 2 1/2" x 14 1/2" strips and eight 2 1/2" x 18 1/2" strips. (Block A)
2. Cut two 11 1/4" strips; subcut four 11 1/4" squares. Cut each square diagonally in both directions to yield sixteen quarter-square triangles. (Block B)

From Fabric G:

1. Use template provided and paper-backed fusible web to prepare four stars for appliqué. (Block A)

Piecing Instructions:

Center Block

1. Sew one 1 1/2" x 18 1/2" D strip to the sides of the 18 1/2" A square. Press toward D. Sew one 1 1/2" x 20 1/2" D strip to the top and bottom of the square; press. (Figure 1)

Block A

1. Sew one 2 1/2" x 14 1/2" F strip to the sides of one 14 1/2" B square. Press toward F. Sew one 2 1/2" x 18 1/2" F strip to the top and bottom of the square; press.
2. Sew one 1 1/2" x 18 1/2" E strip to the sides of the Step 1 block. Press toward E. Sew one 1 1/2" x 20 1/2" E strip to the top and bottom of the block; press.

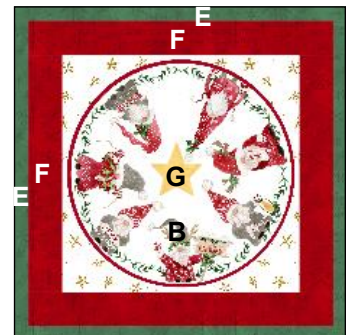


Figure 2 **Make 4.**

3. Fuse prepared G star to the center of the block. Machine applique using your preferred stitch. Repeat steps to make four Block A. (Figure 2)

Block B

1. Sew one 11 1/4" F triangle to both sides of one 10 1/2" A square. Press toward F. Repeat for the top and bottom of the square.

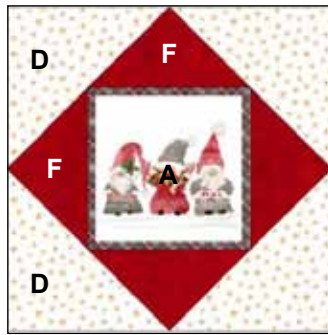


Figure 3 **Make 4.**

2. Sew one 10 7/8" D triangle to opposite sides of the Step 1 block. Press toward D. Repeat for the remaining sides of the block. Repeat steps to make four Block B. (Figure 3)

20 1/2" x 20 1/2" unfinished.

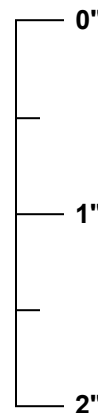
Quilt Assembly:

1. Refer to quilt diagram to sew blocks into rows. Press seams open or in opposite directions from row to row.
2. Sew one 1 1/2" x 60 1/2" D strip to both sides of the quilt center. Press toward D. Sew one 1 1/2" x 62 1/2" D strip to the top and bottom of the quilt; press.

3. Sew one 1 1/2" x 62 1/2" E strip to both sides of the quilt. Press toward E. Sew one 1 1/2" x 64 1/2" E strip to the top and bottom of the quilt; press.
4. Sew one 4 1/2" x 64 1/2" C strip to both sides of the quilt. Press toward C. Sew one 4 1/2" x 72 1/2" C strip to the top and bottom of the quilt; press.

Finishing:

1. Prepare backing using two widths. Press seams open. Trim to 80" x 80".
2. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim layers even with quilt top squaring corners.
5. Join eight 2 1/2" E binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method.
6. Make a label and sew to the back of quilt.



Scale Check for pdf files. When you print these templates, this ruler should measure 2 inches long. If it does not, change, "page scaling" to "none" in the print dialog box.
