## Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

## From Fabric A:

1. Cut two $141 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares centering design within each one. (Block B))

## From Fabric B:

1. Cut two $11 / 4$ " strips; subcut two $11 / 4$ " $\times 121 / 2$ " strips and two 1 1/4" x 14" strips. (Block A)
2. Cut four 1 1/2" strips; subcut four 1 1/2" $\times 14$ 1/2" strips and four 1 1/2" x 16 1/2" strips. (Block B)
3. Cut one $43 / 8$ " strip; subcut two $43 / 8$ " x $101 / 2$ " rectangles. Cut one rectangle diagonally in half. Cut second rectangle diagonally in the opposite direction. Use remainder of strip to cut two $27 / 8$ " $\times 75 / 8$ " rectangles. Cut rectangles in the same way as larger rectangles. (Block A)
4. Cut one 5" strip; subcut one 5" square, two 3 1/2" squares and two 2" squares. (Block A)

## From Fabric C:

1. Cut four 2 1/2" strips. (Binding)
2. Cut one $81 / 4$ " strip; subcut one $81 / 4$ " $\times 97 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Cut lengthwise from bottom corners to top middle to create a triangle. Use remainder of strip to cut one $51 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 7^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Use rectangle to cut one smaller triangle in the same way as the larger one. (Block A) (Figure 1)

## From Fabric D:

1. Cut four $11 / 2$ " strips; subcut four $11 / 2$ " $\times 161 / 2$ " strips and four 1 1/2" x 18 1/2" strips. (Block B)
2. Use template provided and the paper-backed fusible web to prepare eight larger stars for applique. (Block B)

## From Fabric E:

1. Cut two 2 " strips; subcut two 2 " $\times 151 / 2$ " strips and two 2" x 18 1/2" strips. (Block A)

## From Fabric F:

1. Cut two $11 / 4$ " strips; subcut two $11 / 4$ " $\times 14$ " strips and two 1 1/4" x $151 / \mathbf{2 " ~}^{\prime \prime}$ strips. (Block A)

## From Fabric G:

1. Cut one 2" strip; subcut one 2" $\times 3$ 1/2" rectangle and one 2" square. (Block A)

## From Fabric H:

1. Use template provided and the paper-backed fusible web to prepare two large stars and two small stars for appliqué. (Block B)

## Piecing Instructions: <br> Block A

1. Sew one $43 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2$ " B triangle to the side of one
$81 / 4$ " x $97 / 8 " C$ triangle. Press toward B. Sew one reverse $B$ triangle to the opposite side of the $C$ triangle; press.
2. Sew one $31 / 2$ " $B$ square to both sides of the 2" x 3 1/2" G rectangle. Press both seams toward G. Sew this unit to the bottom of the
 Step 1 unit. (Figure 2)
3. Sew one $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 75 / 8^{\prime \prime} B$ triangle to both sides of the $51 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 7^{\prime \prime} C$ triangle. Press toward $B$. Sew one reverse $B$ triangle to the opposite side of the C triangle; press.
4. Sew one 2" B square to both sides of the 2" G square.

Press both seams toward G. Sew this unit to the bottom of the Step 3 unit.
5. Sew the 5" B square to the top of the Step 4 unit. Press toward B.
6. Sew one $11 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime} B$ strip to both sides of the Step 6 unit. Press toward B. Sew one $11 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 14$ " B strip to the top and bottom of the unit; press.
7. Sew one $11 / 4 " \times 14^{\prime \prime}$ F strip to both sides of the Step 6 unit. Press toward F. Sew one $11 / 4$ " x 15 1/2" F strip to the top and bottom of the unit; press.

8. Sew one 2" $\times 15$ 1/2" $E$ strip to both sides of the Step 7 unit. Press toward E. Sew one 2" $\times 18$ 1/2" E strip to the top and bottom of the unit to complete one Block A. (Figure 3)
9. Use template and fusible web to prepare two small H stars. Fuse stars to block and machine applique in place using your preferred stitch.

## Block B

1. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 141 / 2^{\prime \prime} B$ strip to both sides of one $141 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ A square. Press toward A. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 16$ 1/2" $B$ strip to the top and bottom of the square; press.
2. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 161 / 2^{\prime \prime} D$ strip to both sides of the unit from Step 1. Press toward D. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18$ 1/2" D strip to the top and bottom to complete one block.
3. Use template and fusible web to prepare four large D stars and one large H star. Fuse stars to block and machine
