Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips. PLEASE NOTE:

Cut all 3-1/4" squares in half diagonally twice for the mumber of triangles indicated in [].

Cut all 6-7/8" squares in half diagonally for the number of triangles indicated in [].

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of large panel to approximately 18" x 23-1/2"

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 5-1/2" x 65" and (2) 5-1/2" x 53" multi-stripe borders and (2) 3" x 24" button stripe borders

Fabrics C and L - From each fabric: Cut (2) 6-7/8" strips, subcut (8) 6-7/8" squares

Fabrics D and I - From each fabric: Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (16) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric E - Cut (2) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (16) 4-1/2" squares (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (16) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric F - Cut (1) 3-3/8" strip, subcut (8) 3-3/8" squares

Cut (6) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 61-1/2" and (2) 2" x 52-1/2" borders

Fabric H - Cut (1) 6-7/8" strip, subcut (4) 6-7/8" squares <a>[8]

Fabric J - Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (8) 4-1/2" squares

Cut (2) 3-1/4" strips, subcut (16) 3-1/4" squares [64]

Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (2) 2" x 39-1/2" borders

Cut (3) 2" strips, sewn together end

to end and cut into (2) 2" x 48-1/2" borders

Fabric K - Cut (1) 3-1/4" strip, subcut (8) 3-1/4" squares [32]

Fabric M - Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (8) 2-1/2" squares

Cut (2) 1-3/4" strips, subcut (2) 1-3/4" x 26" strips

Cut (2) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 23-1/2" strips

2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew 1 each **Fabrics G** and **H** 6-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 8 Unit 1a (6-1/2" square

unfinished). In the same manner, make 16 Unit 2b with **Fabrics C** and **L** 6-7/8" triangles.

2. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of 8 **Fabric E** 4-1/2" squares in 1 direction, and in the opposite direction on the remaining 8 **Fabric E** 4-1/2" squares.





Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric. Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

3. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all **Fabrics I** and **M** 2-1/2" squares and **Fabric J** 4-1/2" squares (in any direction).



Shading of diagrams may vary depending on fabrics used.

4. Arrange a marked **Fabric J** 4-1/2" square right sides together on Fabric H corner of a Unit 1a as shown. Stitch along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner out. Arrange a marked **Fabric M** 2-1/2" square right sides together on Fabric J corner as shown. Stitch along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner out. Make a total of 8 **Block 1** (6-1/2" square unfinished).

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric. Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

5. Arrange a marked **Fabric E** 4-1/2" square right sides together on Fabric L corner of each Unit 1b as shown, for a total of 4 each arrangement. Stitch across marked lines. Trim seam allowances and press corners out.









6. Referring to Step 4, arrange a marked **Fabric I** 2-1/2" square right sides together on Fabric E corner of each unit from Step 5. Stitch, trim, and press corners out to complete 4 each of **Blocks 2a-2d** (6-1/2" square unfinished).

7. Sew 2 Fabric J 3-1/4" triangles to adjoining sides of a **Fabric D** 2-1/2" square as shown. Make a total of 4 Unit 2a. In the same manner, make 4 each Units 2b-2d with fabrics indicated.

8. Sew 2 Fabric J 3-1/4" triangles to adjoining sides of a Fabric E 2-1/2" square as shown. Add 2 Fabric K 3-1/4" triangles





to Fabric J triangles as shown. Make a total of 4 Unit 3a (4-7/8" x 4-7/8" x 6-7/8" unfinished).

In the same manner, make 4 each Units 3b-3d with fabrics indicated.

9. Stitch 1 each Units 2a and 2b to opposite sides of a Fabric F 3-3/8" square. Add 1 each Units 3a and 3b to



remaining sides as shown. Make a total of 4 Block 3a (6-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 3 Block 3b with Fabric F 3-3/8" squares and units indicated.


- 10. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of panel, strips, blocks, and borders.
- 11. Sew **Fabric B** 3" x 24" border strips to top and bottom of Fabric A panel. Trim strip ends even. Stitch Fabric M 1-1/2" x 23-1/2" strips to sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-3/4" x 26" Fabric M strips to top and bottom of Fabric B border strips. Trim bordered panel to 24-1/2" square (unfinished).
- 12. Arrange 2 Block 1 and 1 each Blocks 2b and 2d in a vertical row on left side of bordered panel. Arrange 2 **Block 1** and 1 each **Blocks 2a** and **2c** in a vertical row on the right side of bordered panel. Stitch vertical rows into side borders (6-1/2" x 24-1/2" unfinished) and sew to right and left sides of bordered panel.

Shading of diagrams may vary depending on fabrics used.

- 13. Arrange 1 each **Blocks 2a** and **2b** and 2 each **Blocks 1**, **2c**, **2d**, **3a**, and **3b** in 2 horizontal rows above bordered panel and side borders. Sew into rows. Sew rows together to complete top pieced border (12-1/2" x 36-1/2" unfinished). Stitch to top of bordered panel and side borders.
- 14. Arrange 1 each **Blocks 2c** and **2d** and 2 each **Blocks 1**, **2a**, **2b**, **3a**, and **3b** in 2 horizontal rows below bordered panel and side borders. Sew into rows. Sew rows together to complete bottom pieced border (12-1/2" x 36-1/2" unfinished). Stitch to bottom of bordered panel and side borders. Quilt center measures 36-1/2" x 48-1/2" (unfinished).
- 15. Sew **Fabric J** 2" x 48-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric J** 2" x 39-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.
- 16. Center **Fabric B** 5-1/2" x 65" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric B** 5-1/2" x 53" borders on top and bottom of quilt center with the pale blue stripe next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric. Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints. 17. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



- 18. Sew **Fabric G** 2" x 61-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric G** 2" x 52-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 19. The quilt measures approximately 52-1/2" x 64-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric N**) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 20. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric J**) and enjoy!!


