



Class: The Fashionable Figure: Regency Chemise

The Regency Chemise is the essential foundation layer for your Bridgerton or Jane Austen outfit—but it also makes comfy sleepwear! In this half-day workshop, you will be guided through the trickier parts of assembling a Regency Chemise. You'll learn how to insert gussets for freedom of movement, how to flat-fell seams for a neat finish, and how to make a drawstring casing.

This class is best suited to intermediate students, but adventurous beginners are welcome (most students will finish at home). \*If you are also taking the Regency Stays workshop, your pattern will be provided. ## Prior to Class please purchase the following:

- Pattern Regency Underthings ePattern by Sense & Sensibility Patterns, available at https://www.sensibility.com/shop/regency-era. \*If you are also taking the Regency Short Stays class, your pattern will be provided, no need to purchase! Please note you will need to print and assemble the pattern before class (the ePattern can be printed on multiple pages with a home printer, or taken to a print shop with a wide-format printer). - Fabric 3 yards of 45" wide pima, lawn, or another lightweight 100% cotton. This is your "next to skin" layer so it should be something soft, light and comfortable. <u>Please wash and dry your fabric BEFORE class!</u> Some good choices at The Sewing Studio:
  - Pima Batiste \$11.55/yd sku 171147
  - Cotton Batiste \$8.55/yd sku 268709
  - Japan Lawn \$13.09/yd sku 171606

- Bias tape I recommend cutting your own bias from the same fabric as your chemise and will teach how to do this in class. If you prefer, you can purchase 1 package of Single Fold Bias Tape.
- **Drawstring** 1/8" cotton cord, ribbon or yarn.
- Also please bring your regular machine sewing supplies such as scissors or rotary cutter, thread, pins, chalk or fabric marking pencil. Classroom machines are available for use but you may bring your own machine if you prefer.

## **Class Policy**

- A minimum of 4 students is needed to make a class a "go". If a class fails to register 4 students you will receive a full refund.
- All students get a 15% discount on all class supplies purchased at <u>The Sewing Studio Fabric</u> <u>Superstore.</u>
