Pattern: Grainline Studio Tamarack Jacket for your size range

Prior to Class: Purchase and pre-wash main/lining fabric for View A.

¼ yd. Fusible Interfacing

Four Coat Hooks and Eyes (optional)

### **Bring to Class**

Pattern

All Fabric - Main and Lining pre-washed and ironed

Binding - Buy extra fabric for bias binding or purchase pre-made.

Batting - I recommended Quilters Request.

Thread

Rotary Cutter

Ruler - 6" x 24" ( My go to ruler for this project is 2.5" x 18")

Scissors - 8" and snips
