

Class: Sewing Basics 1*

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Description: If you are ready to learn how to sew, but not sure where to start, this is the class for you! Maybe you have done some sewing in the past but want to refresh your skills, this is the class for you! You will learn sewing terminology, how to lay out a pattern, pinning, cutting, and the sewing of the garment. We will be making a pair of house/sleeping pants. Register early, classes fill quickly.

Supplies To Bring To Class:

You do not need to purchase supplies/fabric/OR the pattern before the first class. You will have shopping time during the first class session.

Supplies That Will Be Needed:

Dress making scissors (Gingher, Mundial or Kai brands are great!) Round head pins Seam ripper Measuring tape- 60" long Sewing gauge Pin cushion (Grabbit Magnetic Pin Cushion is a good option) Two large safety pins Thread to match fabric Something to carry your supplies in (sewing basket, tote bag, ziplock bag)

Notes: Alert! Most patterns are multi sizes, you will choose your pattern based on your body measurements. You will be taking measurements during class. In Sewing Basics I, you will make house pants, with elastic waist.

Class Policy

A minimum of 4 students is needed to make a class a "go". If a class fails to register 4 students you will receive a full refund.
