

The Wren Press Limited Anti-Slavery and Human Trafficking Policy

- 1.1 Neither The Wren Press Limited, its officers, employees or other persons with which it is associated have ever been convicted of any offence involving human trafficking.
- 1.2 The Wren Press Limited has never been nor is presently the subject of any investigation, inquiry or enforcement proceedings by any governmental, administrative or regulatory body regarding any offence or alleged offence of or in connection with slavery and/or human trafficking.
- 1.3 The Wren Press Limited has in place appropriate due-diligence procedures through enquiry, investigation and certification to ensure that its own suppliers, subcontractors and other supply-chain participants adhere closely to its contractual obligations and principles to ensure that none either directly or through their associates permit or themselves engage in slavery or human trafficking.
