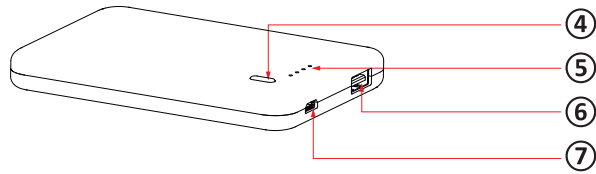
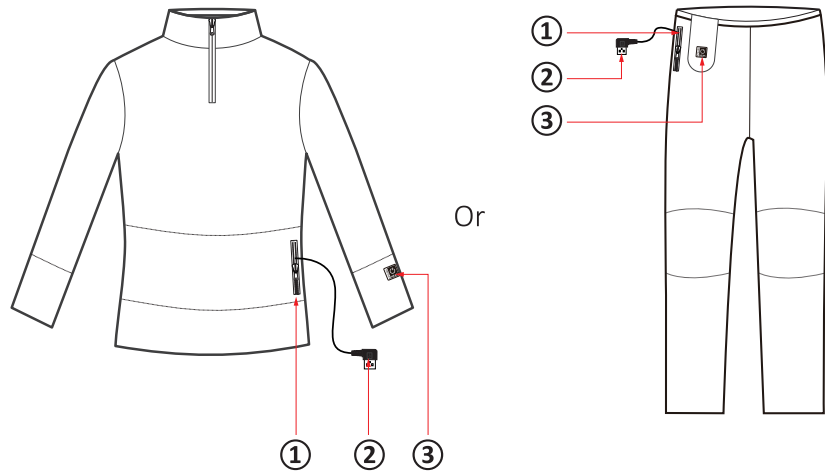
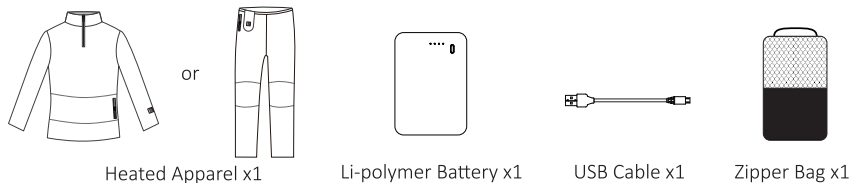


## 1 Product Overview

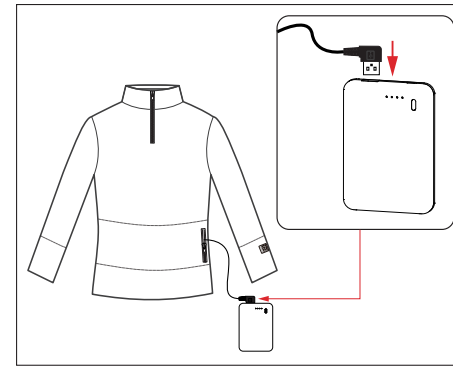


## 2 User Guide

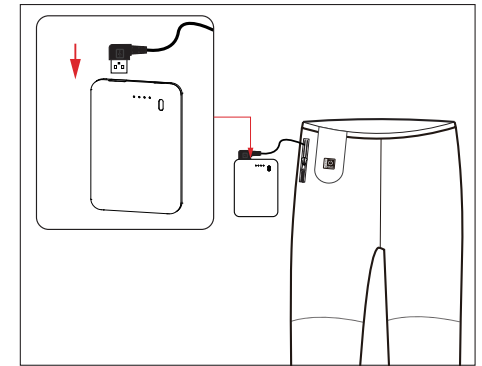
### Step 1. Connect battery with jacket / pants.

### Step 2. Turn ON / Turn OFF

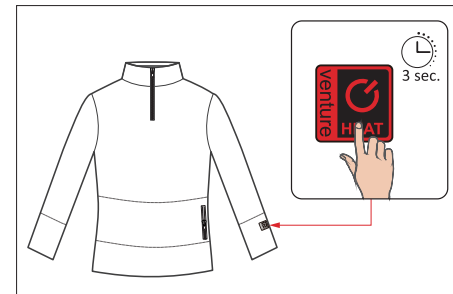
#### 1. Turn ON:

**Press and hold** the temperature controller **3 Seconds** until the red color Turn ON (high temperature)

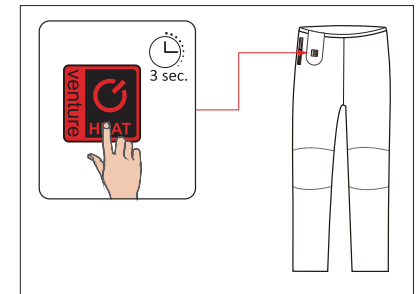
#### 2. Turn OFF:

**Press and hold** the temperature controller **3 Seconds** until the LED Turn OFF.

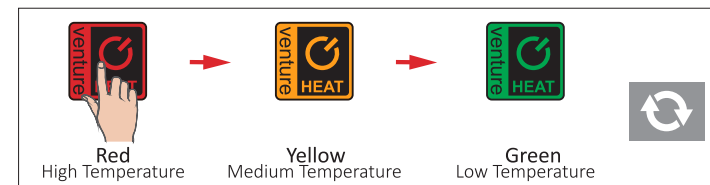

### Step3. Adjust heat level

### 3 Battery Charging and Maintenance

#### Battery Care

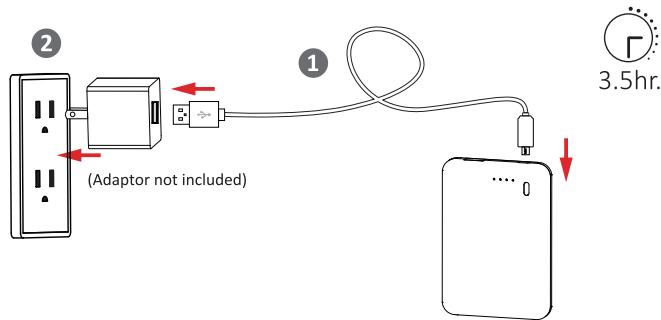
- Battery must be fully charged before storage.
- At least once every 6 months of storage thereafter.

Do not crush, puncture, incinerate or short-circuit.

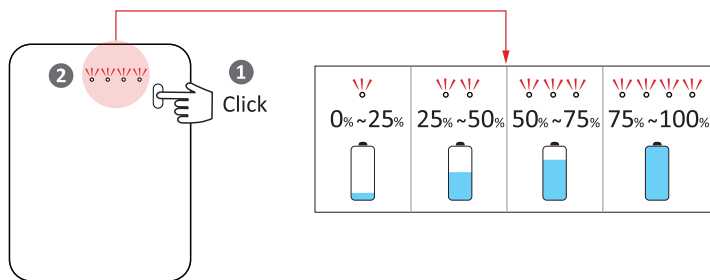
#### 1. Charging your battery. (Fully charge before use)

- 1 Connect battery with charger.
- 2 Plug charger into a power outlet.



#### 2. Check battery status

- 1 Click the Battery button to check battery percentage status.
- 2 LED indicator will flash briefly to indicate remaining charge as:



### 4 Wash and Care
