

Cutlass

A green-to-red blocky variety, Cutlass is well adapted for open field production in all growing regions with high humidity and affected by thrips populations. Cutlass produces high marketable yields with less culls even under stressful weather conditions.

FEATURES

- Strong plant structure with excellent leaf coverage prevents yield loss to sunburn
- Continuous fruit setting allows multiple harvests during the production season
- Consistently large percentage of extra-large fruit with attractive dark green color and glossy appearance
- Unique and powerful disease package with resistance to TSWV and Xcv races 1-5, 7-9
