Pismo is a high-yielding, Huntington type processor bean with a great disease package and an upright plant habit for concentrated production of long, slender, medium-dark pods.

## FEATURES

- Smooth, straight pods
- Upright bush type for consistent yield
- May show some chlorotic leaf spotting, but does not impact yield
- Responds well to high inputs

- Strong tolerance to the Midwest virus complex
- Consistently high raw product yields
- Excellent finished product quality
- Higher pod placement for higher recovery in the field
- Blue Lake type
