# **Edge Pull Installation Instructions**

#### **Before Starting:**

- For new installations, <u>pre-drilling holes is required</u>. Important Note: If you do not pre-drill holes, you risk the screws snapping inside the cabinet. Inspire Hardware is not responsible for any installation issues if these installation instructions are not followed.
- Tightening of screws should be done manually with a screwdriver to avoid over-tightening or stripping the screws or hardware.

### **Required Tools:**

- 1. Drill
- 2. 3/16" drill bit
- 3. Screwdriver
- 4. Pencil or pen

## **Optional:**

5. Painter's tape

## **Installation Steps:**

- 1. Place the edge pull on the cabinet where you would like to install them.
- 2. Once you're happy with placement, from the back of the cabinet door or drawer, use a pencil to mark the screw holes. If you don't want to mark up your cabinet, you can use a piece of painter's tape in the area where the screw holes will go, and make the marks on the painter's tape.
- 3. Take your drill and 3/16" drill bit, and set the bit to the depth of the screws provided.
- 4. Use the drill to pre-drill holes into the back of the cabinet, taking care not to drill through the front.
- 5. Once the pilot holes are drilled in the correct spots, place the pull in the correct spot with the holes aligned.
- 6. Use a screwdriver to tighten the screws into the cabinet. If using a drill for the step, there are risks to stripping the screws or snapping them in the cabinet, therefore it is recommended to use a screwdriver.
- 7. Stand back and enjoy your new hardware!
