PREPARE YOUR QUILT

Please:

1. Bring your quilt as a separate top and back. **Do NOT pin or baste** the pieces together. Press the quilt carefully, making sure the seams lie flat. Let it cool. Place on hanger to keep it from getting creased.
2. Make sure your quilt top is as square or rectangular as possible. Take out any fullness you may have in the Border. This will make it easier to get a professional-looking product.
3. If top or back is directional, please mark desired top of the design with pins.

Borders:

We recommend you cut your Border strips lengthwise. The fabric strips will lie flatter when sewn and pressed to the quilt top.

Backing:

Backing should measure 12-inches larger around outside of quilt, so that there is 6-inches extra fabric on top, bottom, and both sides of the backing. All excess fabric and batting will be returned to you. Make sure the edges of the back are cut straight and even to make loading it on the longarm easier.

Batting:

We carry batting, but feel free to bring your own. Batting should measure the same 12-inches extra around as the back. Inferior quality batting can ruin a quilt when washed or dry cleaned. Remember, you have put all this effort into making something beautiful, with quilt shop quality fabric; you certainly don't want to ruin it with second-rate batting.

Pricing:

We price our quilts by square inch and charge for thread, and batting, along with any additional services needed. We do all-over patterns, known as Edge-to-Edge. Edge-to-edge patterns start at \$.02 per square inch. More complex patterns are priced \$.02-\$.03 per inch. These patterns start at the top of the quilt and continue with the same pattern throughout the quilt. We will use one color thread, or variegated (multi-colored) thread, depending on what we think would look best on the quilt, or the quilter may choose the thread.

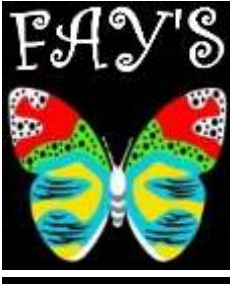
The non-cotton backing surcharge is \$10 for fabrics such as fleece, minky, or snuggle fabrics which are extremely stretchy and warrant careful and constant watching on the longarm to ensure that no folds or tucks are created during the quilting process.

Turn-Around Time: Turn-around time for finishing quilts is generally 3-4 weeks.

Scent/Odor Free Policy: Please be considerate. Quilt tops and backs should be odor free- free from smoke, pet smells, food odors, and any other strong fragrances. If you think your quilt has any odors, kindly air it out. We reserve the right to not accept items with strong odors.

Binding Service: Let us put the finishing touches on your quilt with our Binding Service, and get your quilt back completely finished. ALL DONE! A-A-A-A-A-A-A-H-H-H!
