



I M P O R T A N T S A F E G U A R D S

While we know you are eager to use your Wine Connoisseur Sommelier System, please keep the following in mind for safe operation of the system. To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and/or injury to persons when using electrical systems, basic safety precautions should always be followed. These include the following:

- 1. Read all instructions.
- 2. This system must be properly installed and located in accordance with these instructions prior to use.
- 3. This system is intended for adults of legal drinking age.
- 4. This system is not intended for use by children or by persons with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge.
- 5. Close supervision is necessary when any system is used near children.
- 6. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the system.
- 7. To protect against a risk of electrical shock, do not immerse cord, plug, or base in water or other liquid.
- 8. Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning or maintenance. To unplug, grasp the plug and pull from the outlet. Never pull from the power cord.
- 9. Do not operate any system with a damaged cord or plug, or after the system malfunctions or has been dropped or damaged in any manner.
- 10. Supply cord replacement and repairs must be conducted by the manufacturer, its service agent, or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- 11. Contact Customer Service to report any malfunction of or damage to the system. 12. Do not use outdoors.

- 13. Only use wine glasses that fit under the dispensing area of the system for proper pour.
- 14. The use of accessory attachments not recommended or sold by the system manufacturer may cause injuries.
- 15. Do not use if system is broken, chipped, or damaged in any way.
- 16. Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner or in a heated oven.
- 17. Water reservoir is for water only. Do not fill with any other liquid.
- 18. Do not overfill the water reservoir
- with water.
 19. Do not lift the sachet door when a drink is being prepared.
- 20. Do not use system for other than intended use.
- 21. CAUTION: The system has a sharp cutting mechanism that punctures the wine sachet. To avoid risk of injury, do not put your fingers under the sachet door.
- 22. Use only with the power supply cord provided with the system.
- 23. Replacement and repairs must be conducted by the manufacturer, its service agent, or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- 24. Only use wine sachets sold or recommended by the system manufacturer.
- 25. Do not pour wine directly into the system.
- 26. Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter.
- 27. Do not let cord contact hot surface, including the stove.
- 28. Wipe dry the water reservoir connector at the base of the unit after removing the water reservoir.
- 29. ONLY USE APPROVED WINE SACHETS.
- 30. Avoid contacting moving parts. Do not attempt to defeat any safety interlock mechanisms.



WINE CONNOISSEUR SOMMELIER USER GUIDELINES

WARNING: POURING WINE OR ANY LIQUID DIRECTLY INTO THE HOPPER MAY CREATE LEAKAGE AND POSSIBLE ELECTRICAL HAZARD. DO NOT INSERT MORE THAN ONE SACHET AT A TIME IN THE HOPPER.

FIRST TIME USAGE

To utilize your Wine Connoisseur Sommelier System for the first time:

- STEP I: Fill water reservoir to "MAX FILL" indicator.
- STEP 2: Place empty clean cup on drip tray.
- STEP 3: Press and hold the center button for 2 seconds to turn the unit on.
- STEP 4: CLEAN button will blink BLUE prompting a CLEAN cycle (Please note, if the water reservoir needs water, the center button will blink BLUE).

 Fill water reservoir to MAX FILL level.
- STEP 5: To start the CLEAN cycle hold CLEAN button for 4 seconds and center power button will blink blue.
- STEP 6: Blue light will turn white and the door will automatically open when CLEAN cycle is completed.
- STEP 7: Replace clean cup with wine glass on drip tray.
- STEP 8: Gently straighten the sachet including the top area so there are no bends. Do not crease or distort the sachet in any way.









- STEP 9: Straighten the top before inserting WC wine sachet.


 Insert WC sachet top down.
- STEP IO: If system is ready, the light ring will glow WHITE.
- STEP II: Press the WHITE/ROSÉ button for WHITE or ROSÉ wine, ring light will turn YELLOW or BLUSH PINK.



- STEP 13: When the dispense is complete, the wine door will open and a chime will sound.
- STEP 14: Remove and discard the empty sachet.








CONTROL PANEL OVERVIEW

CARING FOR YOUR WINE CONNOISSEUR SOMMELIER SYSTEM

EXTERNAL CLEANING

To clean the surface of your system, wipe with a damp cloth to remove anything on the surface of the system and then dry. To protect the finish of your system, make sure to not use harsh soaps, detergents, or rough sponges to clean the surface. Certain topical products such as sunblock, lotions, etc. may damage the finish of your system if left behind on the surface.

INTERNAL CLEANING

There are two ways to clean your system. A CLEAN using just water, and a CLEAN WITH VINEGAR which requires 100% distilled white vinegar.

The system will occasionally require a cleaning cycle, indicated by the CLEAN light indicator blinking blue, but you can choose to run a cycle at any time by closing the door and holding the CLEAN button for 4 seconds.

A CLEAN is required after startup and before shutdown. Be sure to run a CLEAN before turning off or unplugging the system.

ACTIVATING A CLEAN / CLEAN WITH VINEGAR

If the system has not been used in 10 days or longer, then a DEEP CLEAN is necessary to keep the system clean.

- 1. Press OPEN/CLOSE DOOR button to ensure that wine sachet has been removed from the device.
- 2. Place CLEAN cup on drip tray.
- 3. Empty the water reservoir and add 100% distilled white vinegar to the CLEAN FILL level.
- 4. Close door and hold CLEAN button for 4 seconds. Center blue light should blink and chime to confirm the CLEAN has started.
- 5. System door will open and chime will ring to confirm that clean has been completed.
- 6. Empty water reservoir and rinse clean.
- 7. Refill water reservoir with only water to the top and run a standard CLEAN cycle by pressing the CLEAN button for 4 seconds.
- 8. Run a second CLEAN cycle with only water to ensure the vinegar is out of the system.

NOTE: The light ring may blink blue to indicate that the water reservoir level is low. Fill the reservoir to continue. Any other servicing should be performed by an authorized service representative.

TROUBLESHOOTING

LID WON'T OPEN/CLOSE

I BEEP/ORANGE BLINK

- **CAUSES:** 1. Please ensure that the path of the lid is free of any obstructions.
 - 2. Restart System by holding the power button for 2 seconds until light turns off. Wait 5 seconds and then press the center button again for 2 seconds to turn system back on.
 - 3. Call Support at 877-216-2250.

SACHET IS NOT BEING OPENED

2 BEEPS/ORANGE BLINKS

- C A U S E S: 1. Please ensure that sachet is not folded inside and free of creases.
 - 2. Restart System by holding the power button for 2 seconds until light turns off. Wait 5 seconds and then press the center button again for 2 seconds to turn system back on.
 - 3. Call Support at 877-216-2250.

3 BEEPS/ORANGE BLINKS

- **CAUSES:** 1. Restart System by holding the power button for 2 seconds until light turns off. Wait 5 seconds and then press the center button again for 2 seconds to turn system back on.

WINE NOT SUFFICIENTLY CHILLED

4 BEEPS/ORANGE BLINKS

- C A U S E S: 1. Please ensure that sachet is not folded inside and free of creases.
 - 2. Restart System by holding the power button for 2 seconds until light turns off. Wait 5 seconds and then press the center button again for 2 seconds to turn system back on.

WATER RESERVOIR NEEDS TO BE FILLED
