ABODE SPOKE SIDE TABLE





These tables were once the central part of the axel from old wooden carriages. Foraged from traditional village markets, these small tables are made of a variety of natural hard and soft timbers, depending on their location, and have all survived the test of use in a previous life. And while most are made according to simple traditional designs, each one is different in some way. They are typically made from a variety of timbers such as Elm, Pine, Okan, Bingtangor, Mahogany and Sycamore. Due to the ambiguity of each piece's distinct heritage properties, we have called these traditional woods Ceena.
