

Jewellery Sizing Guide



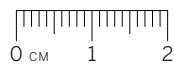
Whether you are looking for a gift for a loved one or yourself, we are here to assist you in determining the best size for your B.P. de Silva heirloom in the making.

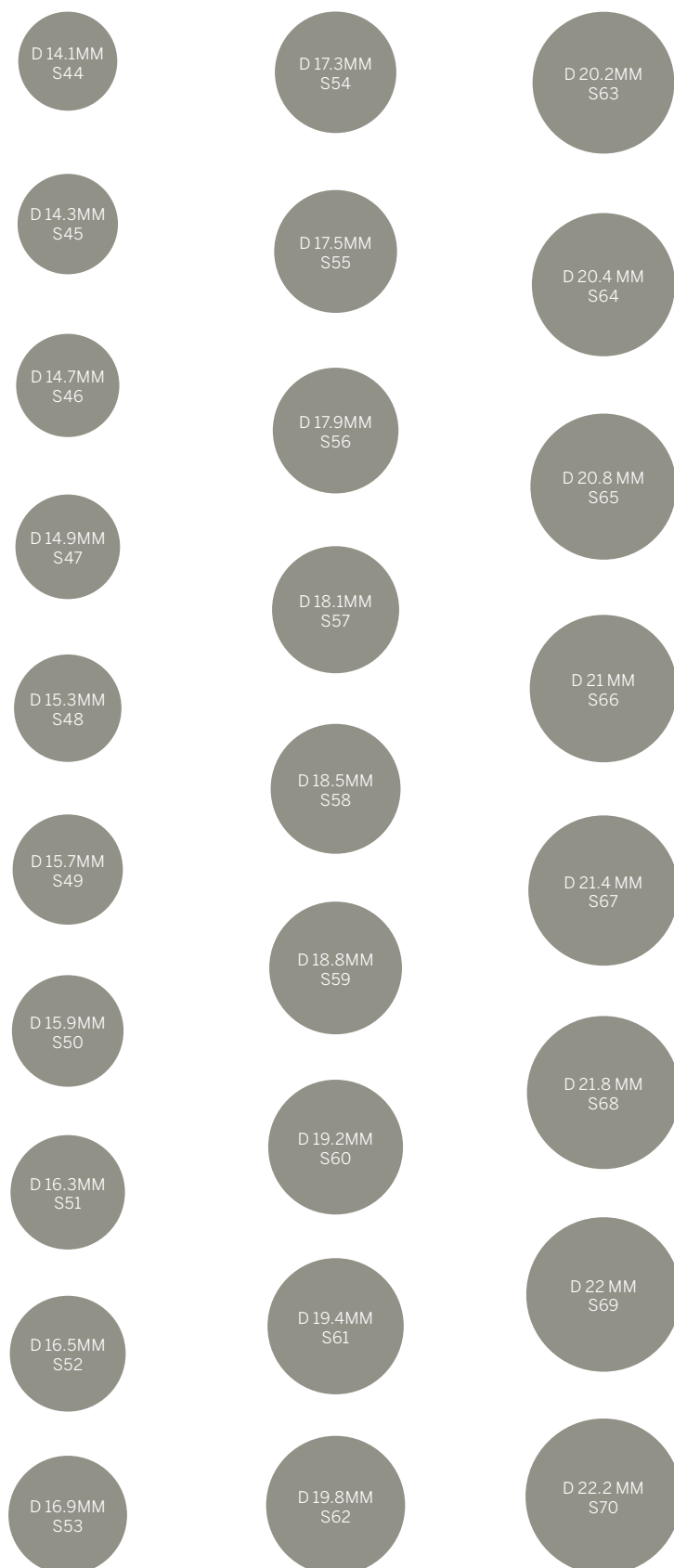
Before printing this guide, please follow the instructions below:

To achieve the best results, you will need to go to the 'printing settings' before printing and ensure that the 'page scaling' option is set to 'none' in the print dialogue box.

The Ring Size Chart must be printed on a full "A4 (21x29.7 cm)" size page to ensure accuracy.

To be sure that the Ring Size Chart has been printed properly, take a ruler and measure the sample below. If the print out is accurate, it should measure exactly 2 cm.





Ring Size Guide

Method 1 : Using a Ring You Already Own and Our Printable Guide

1. Print this guide with page scaling set to 100%.

2. Place a ring that you already own (or have borrowed, if this is a surprise engagement or a gift) over the circles to the right.

3. Match the inside of the ring to the circle nearest in size.

The measurements shown refer to a ring's inner diameter. Match your ring to the circle nearest in size to get a more accurate result.

4. If your ring falls in between two sizes, we recommend to go for the larger size.

Method 2 : Using a String or Ribbon

Measuring your finger is another way to determine your ring size at home. Have a go at this fuss-free method.

1. Use a light-coloured string or ribbon with a length of 10cm, and wrap it comfortably around the largest part of your finger - for many, it is the joint nearest to the knuckle (as illustrated). Take a pen, and mark this point on the string.
2. Measure the points on your string with a ruler.
3. Refer to the "circumference" measurements on the next page to determine your ring size.
4. Should your measurement fall in between sizes, we would recommend to size up.

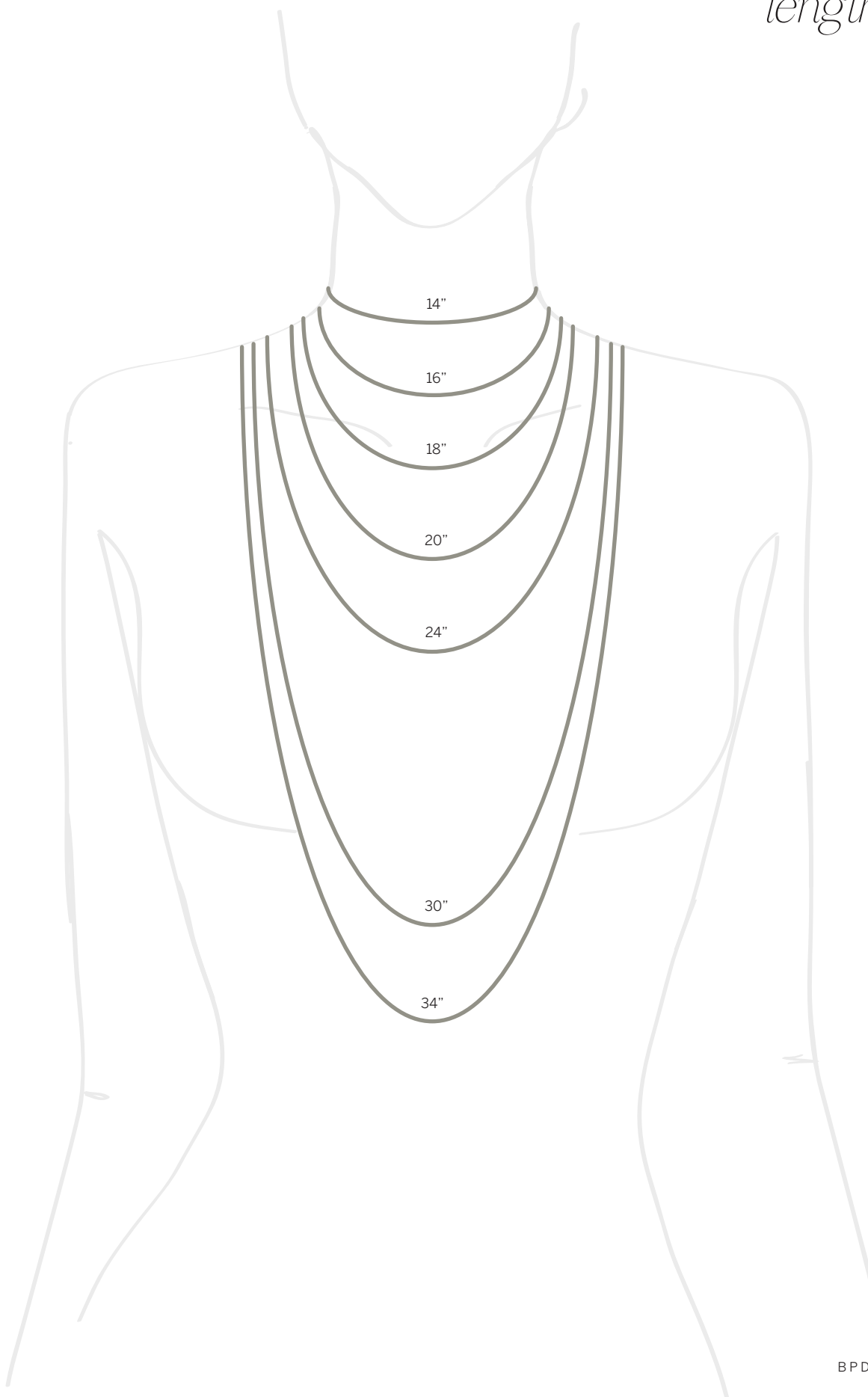

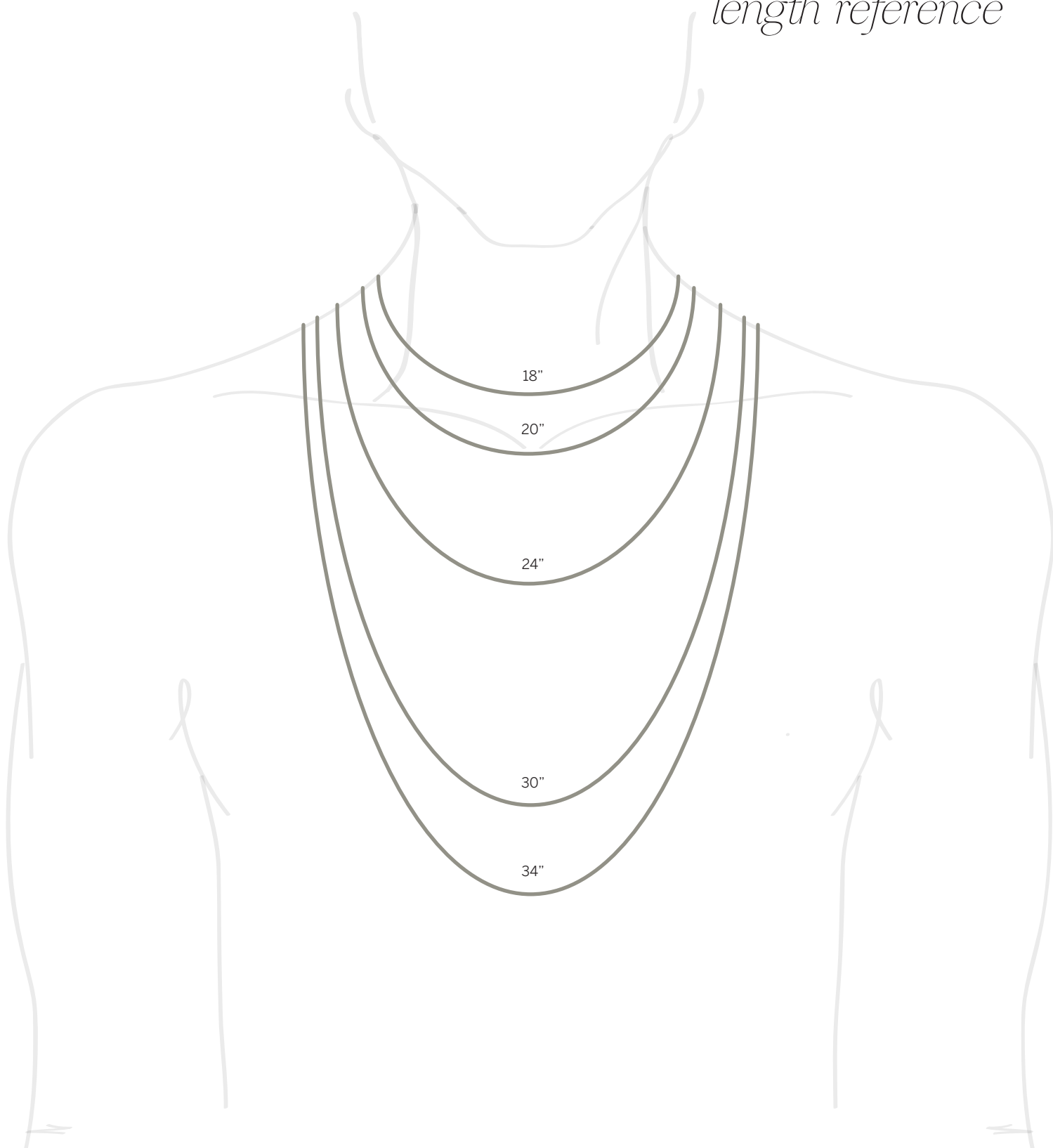

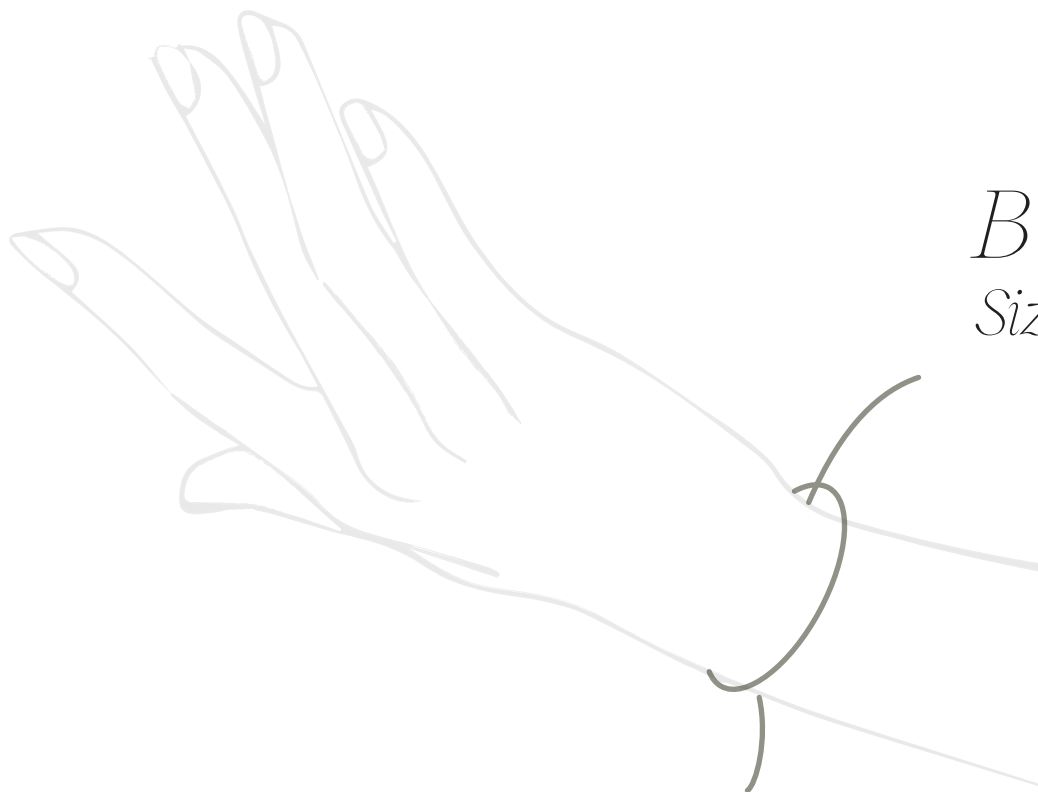

Bracelet Size Guide



How to measure your bracelet size

1. Measure the part of your wrist where you'd like to wear the bracelet with a soft measuring tape. Make it as snug as you'd like for your bracelet to fit you. Refer to our chart above to discover your bracelet size.

2. If you don't have a soft measuring tape, use a light string or ribbon about 25cm in length. Wrap it around your wrist, and use a pen to mark out where the strings meet. Refer to our chart above to discover your bracelet size.
