

Who do you see?

What animals are they?

What are Mouse & Mole doing?

# **Activities**

Find out about animals that live in the wild.

Make picture sets of the animals that live in trees, in holes, in water.

Create a small woodland play area.

Visit a park or woodland and collect natural objects.



# **Inside spread**

## **Discussion**

Here are portraits.

A portrait is a painting of a person or animal.

Which is on the left/right?

What is on Mouse's portrait?

What do you see stuck on Mole's portrait?

## **Activities**

Look for portraits in books or at the museum.

Paint or draw a portrait of your friend – do this in pairs.

Look at and talk about portraits of famous people.





# **Dedication/contents**

### **Discussion**

Sometimes the author will dedicate the book to someone – this one is dedicated to Joy Whitby.

Who would you dedicate your book to?

The contents page is on the right – this tells us what stories are in the book.


How many stories are there in this book?

### **Activities**


Look at other books to see who they have been written for or dedicated to

# Pages 5-13 - 'Half a Bannana'

# Interesting words

### Discussion

Share /read the story – what did Mole like to do with half his food?

What is your favourite snack?

Where would you hide your half?

What snack shall we have this week?

Can you remember where Mole hid his half banana?

What did he hide in the drawer?

Where did he put his crunchy-munchy?

Did Mouse know they were Mole's snacks? Would you have eaten them?

# Activities

List your top ten favourite treats, food, toys etc.

Hide snack-sized treats and mini toys outdoors and send the children on a treasure hunt.

Talk about keeping foods fresh – how do we do this?

Play location games – hide an object and give cold/warm/hot tips as they get closer to it.

### **Discussion**

What does preposterous mean?

Say the word again in a loud voice, a squeaky voice and a whisper.

Who likes puddles?

Read/share the story.

Look at the pictures – are they having fun?

Which would you like to have, a stick or a puddle?

What would you call your stick/puddle?

Was Mouse being kind to Mole?

Who did they meet on their way home?

## **Activities**

Make puddles to sail paper boats in.

What can sticks be used for? Think of things a stick could become.

Make magic wands and create potions.

Add some ink to your water puddles indoors and create paintings.

# **Discussion**

Read/share the story.

Why were Mouse and Mole sad?

What did they realise about the pebbles?

### Activities


Collect pebbles:

Paint them and leave them in nooks around the park/area for others to take home.







#### **Discussion**

What do you see on the back cover?

The title and author/illustrator's names.


There is also a blurb – this is a short version of the whole book.
