






Frog's Bog colour

Common Frogs are amphibians, meaning they live on land and in water. They breathe with their lungs and through their skin which varies in colour from green to brown, red or yellow. These colours can adjust to blend in with their surroundings, which include woodland, gardens, hedgerows and grassland. They breed in ponds in the Spring and settle down to rest in muddy burrows, compost heaps and decaying leaves in winter.
