

Who can you see?

What are they doing?



Inside spread

Discussion

Whale – whales (minke species)

Pod/herd - collective word.

How many can you see?

Activities

Listen to whale song.



Pages 6 & 7

Discussion

Have you been to the beach?

Did you collect anything?

What did Molly and Dylan see?

Activities

Create postcards from the different beaches the children have visited – display them.



Pages 8 & 9

Discussion

In what did Dad carry Molly and Dylan to the beach?

Wheelbarrow - where do we usually use a wheelbarrow? For what?

Activities

Create a game – moving bean bags from one place to another – tag team.



Pages 10 & 11

Discussion

How many people have come to help?

Can you see Molly?

What is everyone doing?

Activities

Create hand-prints – write on them ways of helping others.



Pages 12 & 13

Discussion

Why are they unable to carry the whale back into the sea?

How heavy is the whale? About the same as 8 buses.

Why is it important to give the whale shade?

Activities

Weighing using blocks or non-standardised units...more than/less than/ the same as.



Pages 14 & 15

Discussion

What did Molly do?

Do you enjoy singing? What is your favourite song?

Activities

Tune 'Lawr ar lan y môr'

Molly saw a giant whale.

On the sandy beach...

We then heard Molly sing a song.

Pages 16 & 17

Discussion

Molly was trying to help.

Poor whale – what else would you have done to help?



Pages 18 & 19

Discussion

The tide is coming in.

Can you see the reflection?

What is floating in the water?

Activities

Experiment with objects -which will float / sink?



Pages 20 & 21

Discussion

O no! What is the matter now?

How does everyone look? Worried? Frightened?

Activities

Create a mood board... happy/ sad/ scared -drawing pictures to match the feelings.



Pages 22 & 23

Discussion

Who stayed with the whale all night?

Would you like to sleep under the stars?

Have you stayed in a tent camping?

Activities

Create a tent or shelter with the children outdoors for play or reading.



Pages 24 & 25

Discussion

What happened?

Whose tail can you see in the water?

The whale is diving.

Activities

Create a 'who's tail'? game.



Pages 26 & 27

Discussion

Hurray! The whale was swimming.

Who is able to swim?

Where do you go to swim?



Pages 28 & 29

Discussion

He is blowing water through his blow hole.

Then...what do you think the whale did next?

Activities

The smallest to the biggest – compare sizes, order, group items.



Pages 30 & 31

Discussion

Wow! He jumped over the boat!

What shape did he make? An ark or rainbow shape.

Activities

Singular & plural game:

Cup-cups

Bucket - buckets



Pages 32 & 33

Discussion

They are going home happy.

Can you see the whale?

What is he doing now?

Activities

Discuss looking after beaches-collecting rubbish/ plastic pollution.

Discussion

Information about the author/illustrator – where are they from?



Back inner spreads

Discussion

What do you see in the picture?


How many seagulls are there?
