# **STEP 1**Remove Rubber Cane Tip

### If your tip is difficult to remove, try one of these helpful suggestions:

- While holding the rubber tip, use a turning motion to twist & loosen.
- Use something like a heavy duty paper clip to break suction seal between tip & cane shaft.
   Be careful not to scratch the cane shaft.
- Use a hair dryer to heat the rubber material to make it softer.

# STEP 2 Print page with correct printer settings

### You must confirm that the page will print at its actual size.

- -You may need to click "View More Settings" in your printer window.
- Make sure "Scale to Fit" or "Fit to Printable Area" are not selected
- Make sure Scale (%) is set at 100%



# STEP 3 - Use a quarter to Confirm Size of printed page.

Place a quarter on this quarter image to confirm the size matches. Once size is confirmed proceed to STEP 4

# STEP 4 - Match the end of your cane shaft to the circles below.

Make sure the dotted lines touch exactly to the sides of your cane. Do not purchase cane accessories larger or smaller than the measured size of cane.

#### Please NOTE: Make sure to measure the cane shaft with the cane tip removed
