Construction Instructions



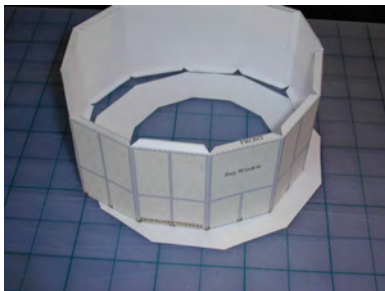
Here are all the tools you need to create the Old Globe Theatre at Balboa Park, San Diego California. All you really need is glue & scissors. I prefer hot glue, but this can be hazardous around smaller children. If this is the case, I recommend ordinary white glue. I also use a straight edge and a dry pen for scoring the fold lines. I highly recommend scoring the fold lines.



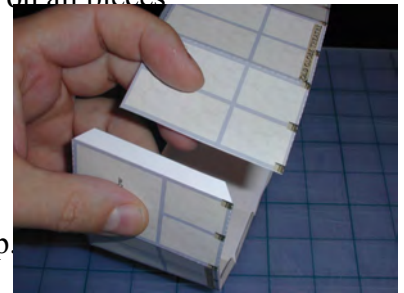
Step 1. Cut out all of the parts. Cut along the perimeter black lines.



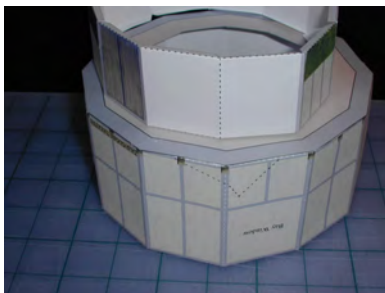
Step 2. Score along all of the dashed fold lines on all pieces.



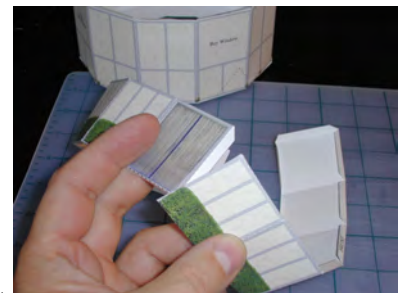
Step 3. Locate the two second floor sides (No bushes), and glue them end to end to form a circle as shown.



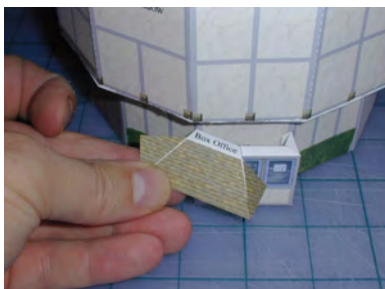
Step 4. Locate the first / second floor. Be sure to turn it upside down, or with the white side up. Place it on your work surface. Next align and glue each second floor tab to the floor, aligning the second floor walls with the outside perimeter of the floor. I prefer to glue one tab, then the tab directly across, and repeat.



Step 5. Now, locate the two first floor walls (the ones with the bushes). Glue them end to end as you did with the second floor walls.



Step 6. Take the second floor assembly, turn it over, and glue the first floor to it. Now the second floor assembly is on your work surface 'up side down'. Make sure you glue the first floor walls up side down. Bushes go up. Also be sure to align the correct walls on the first and second floor. The double white first floor walls align with the second floor walls with the dashed roof lines as shown.



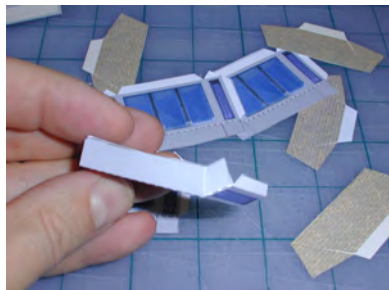
Step 7. Next, glue the box office to the first floor where indicated. Be sure to align the bottom of the box office with the bottom of the walls.



Step 8. Glue the box office roof in place by applying glue to the roof tab and the box office wall tabs. Push the roof tab as far up towards the second floor

overhang as possible.

Step 9: Next, assemble the second floor bay windows. Glue the bottom tabs together while holding the walls at a 90 degree angle. Don't put the bay window roofs on yet.



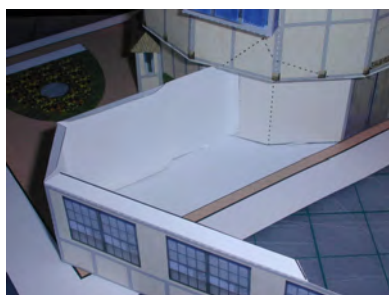
Step 10: Glue the bay windows in place where indicated. Align the bottoms of the windows with the line across the middle of the second floor as shown.

Step 11: The bay window roofs glue in place the same way as the box office roof. Glue roof tab and the wall tabs and press in place.



Step 12: Align the roof with the top of the second floor walls.

Step 13: Now, glue the building assembly to the base. Align the walls in the correct position so the box office and doors are correct. Start with one tab, then glue the opposite tab, the repeat as you go around the building.



Step 15: Now we build the annex. Locate the two annex sides and glue them end to end.

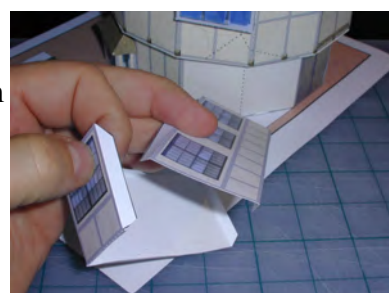
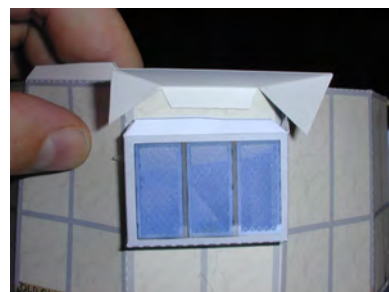
Step 16: Glue the front annex wall to the main structure making sure you align the wall properly.

Step 17: Assemble the annex roof by gluing the roof tab in place as shown.



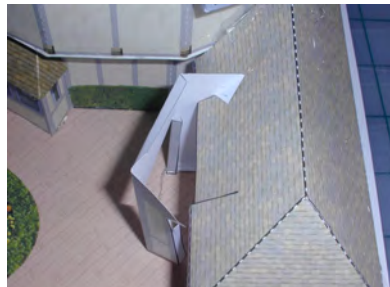
Step 18: Carefully align the annex roof and glue in place to the main structure follow the dashed glue lines.

Step 19: Assemble the annex main entrance by gluing the base tabs together aligning the walls at a 90 degree angle.

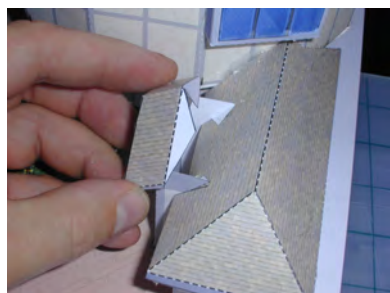

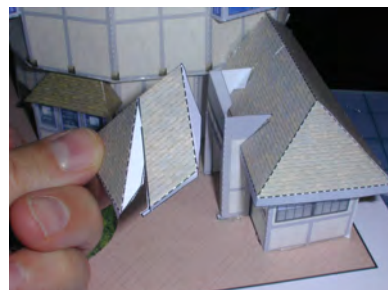

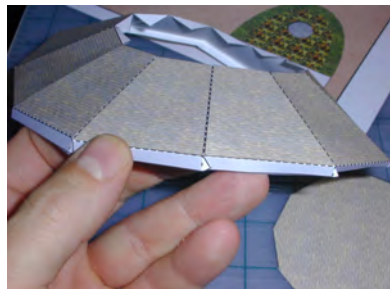
Step 20: Carefully glue the annex main entrance to the annex. Make sure the tabs that glue to the roof are square and straight.



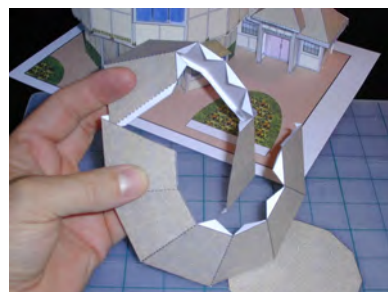
Step 21: Glue the annex main entrance roof together by gluing the tab in place.



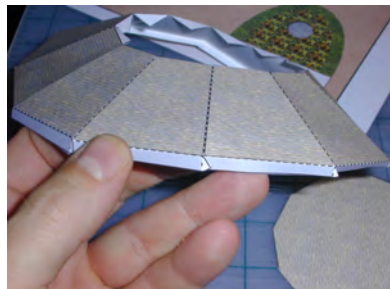
Step 22: Glue the roof in place as shown.



Step 23: Let's work on the main structure roof. Locate the two sections and glue them end to end.



Step 24: Glue the little ends on the fascia together to make the ends square.



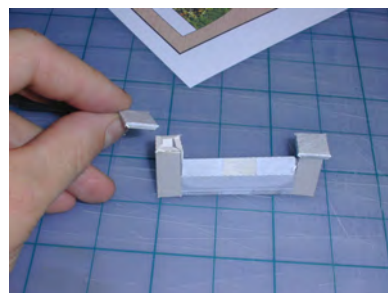
Step 25: Glue the roof center to the tabs as shown.



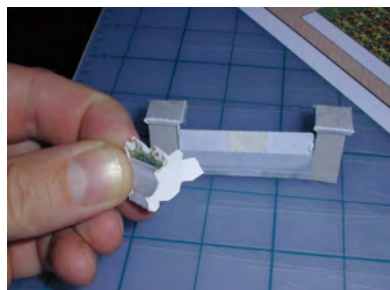
Step 26: Glue the garden wall to itself as shown.



Step 27: Glue the wall caps as shown.



Step 28: Glue the flower pots to themselves as shown.



Step 29: Glue the completed flower pots to the wall caps.

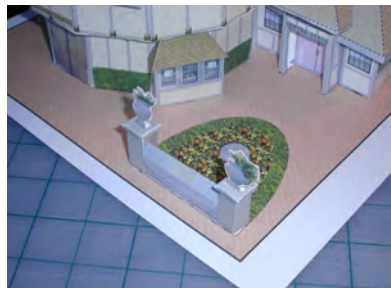


Step 30: Next, glue the garden wall to the base as shown.

Step 31: Fold the bench seat and back as shown.

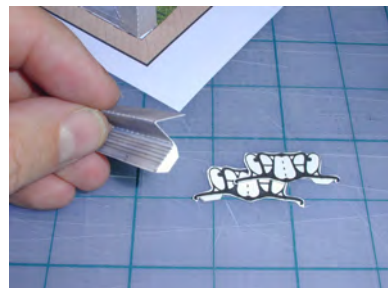

Step 32: Fold and glue the bench ends to themselves as shown.



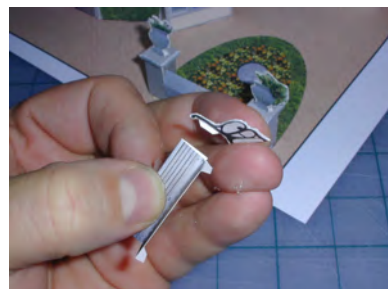
Step 33: Glue the completed bench ends to the bench seat and back.



Step 34: Glue the garden clock to itself as shown.



Step 35: Glue the lamp post to itself as shown.



Step 36: Glue the garden clock to the clock base in the garden.



Step 37: Glue the lamp post as shown.



Step 38: Last step. Glue the sign to the side of the main building as shown.
