CLUE #17

I can't believe we are on our last strip (2) It's good and bad, and I feel emotional about it. This by no means we are done, but this is the last official knitting clue, then it's on to sewing, and the edging.

This strip has absolutely ZERO rules. We are going to throw caution to the wind, we're going to embrace our new love of randomness, and not matching. We are going to relax, put our feet up and knit. We should have a glass of wine I think to celebrate (or whatever beverage makes you the happiest...Not gonna lie, I'm a coffee fanatic, and my dear friend made a mailbox delivery of some Kicking Horse Pass Grizzly Bear coffee, which I'm dying to brew up)

So here's the plan (everyone should be pretty low on yarn at this point, you may be out of some colours, not to worry)

This is your signature piece! You are the captain.

Cast on 30 sts. Work 320 rows in as many stripes of colour as you like, do 2 rows, or 4, 6 or 8, it's entirely up to you and your stash. Just make sure at the end it's the same length as the rest.
