TALLULAH'S TOQUE



MATERIALS:

3 various colours of Tangled Poets Haiku's (mini skeins) (30 grams/110 yards)

These are used triple stranded to achieve an aran weight gauge.

Stitch merker

4inch pompom

NEEDLES REQUIRED:

5.0mm16 inch circular needle, dpn's or longer circular can also be used for megic loop if preferred.

GAUGE: 16 STS & 20 ROWS = 4 INCHES

SIZE: 20 INCHES (FITS AVERAGE ADULT)

PATTERN:

With all three strands held together. Cast on 72 sts. Join in the round, being mindful not to twist. Place stitch marker to

indicate the beginning of each round

Workin Kl. Plribfor 7 rows.

Work in stockinette stitch for 25 rows, (6 inches from cast on edge)

Begin Decreasing for the top:

Row1: (K2tog, K10) rep 6 times total

Row2 and all even numbered rows: Knit

Row3: (K2tog, K9) rep 6 times total

Row5: (K2tog, K8) rep6timestotal

Row7: (K2tog, K7) rep6timestotal

Row9: (K2tog, K6) rep6timestotal

Row11: (K2tog, K5) rep 6 timestotal

Row13: (K2tog, K4) rep 6 times total

Row15: (K2tog, K3) rep 6 times total

Row17: (K2tog, K2) rep 6 times total

Row19: (K2tog, KI) rep 6 times total

Row21: (K2tog) rep 6 times, break yarn and thread through the 6 stitches, pull tight, and tie off, weave in the end.

Attach PomPom

If your pomhas an elastic, sewa regular button from your button jar to the inside of the toque, use a crochet hook and pull the elastic loop through, and around the button.

If your pomhas a snap, sew the snap to outside of your toque, and attach pom
