

TALLULAH'S TOQUE



MATERIALS:

3 various colours of Tangled Poets Haikus (mini skeins)
(30grams/110yards)

These are used triple stranded to achieve an aran weight gauge.

Stitch marker

4 inch pompom

NEEDLES REQUIRED:

5.0mm 16 inch circular needle, dpn's or longer circular can also be used for magic loop if preferred.

GAUGE: 16 STS @ 20 ROWS = 4 INCHES

SIZE: 20 INCHES (FITS AVERAGE ADULT)

PATTERN:

With all three strands held together. Cast on 72 sts. Join in the round, being mindful not to twist. Place stitch marker to indicate the beginning of each round

Work in K1, P1 rib for 7 rows

Work in stockinette stitch for 25 rows, (6 inches from cast on edge)

Begin Decreasing for the top:

Row1: (K2tog, K10) rep 6 times total

Row2 and all even numbered rows: Knit

Row3: (K2tog, K9) rep 6 times total

Row5: (K2tog, K8) rep 6 times total

Row7: (K2tog, K7) rep 6 times total

Row9: (K2tog, K6) rep 6 times total

Row11: (K2tog, K5) rep 6 times total

Row13: (K2tog, K4) rep 6 times total

Row15: (K2tog, K3) rep 6 times total

Row17: (K2tog, K2) rep 6 times total

Row19: (K2tog, K1) rep 6 times total

Row21: (K2tog) rep 6 times, break yarn and thread through the 6 stitches, pull tight, and tie off, weave in the end

Attach PomPom

If your pom has an elastic, sew a regular button from your button jar to the inside of the toque, use a crochet hook and pull the elastic loop through, and around the button.

If your pom has a snap, sew the snap to outside of your toque, and attach pom
