#### Aberdeen's Wool Company

#### Trainwreck Rosie



#### **Materials:**

- 1 skein of Cotton Supreme DK Seaspray in Grape (CC)
- 1 Skein of Cotton Supreme DK Seaspray in Honeydew (MC)
- 4.5 mm Circular needle (can be done on straight needles, but you may want the wingspan)

**Gauge:** 4 sts= inch unblocked, in stockinette stitch

#### **Abbreviations:**

k- knitp- purl k2tog- knit 2togetheryo-yarn overpm – place markersm-slip marker

# **PATTERN:**

Work garter tab as follows →

With MC cast on 3 sts, knit 6 rows, turn work 90 degrees, pick up 3 stitches, turn work 90 degrees again, pick up another 3 sts.

(9 stitches on needle)

(WS) Set-up Row #1 – k3, p3, k3

(RS) Set-up ROW #2 →k3, (yo, k1,yo) pm, k1, pm (yo, k1, yo) k3 (WS) Set-up ROW#3 → K3, purl to marker, sm, p1, sm, purl to next marker, k3

**Stockinette Section: (Always worked in MC)** 

Row 1-(RS) K3, (yo, knit to marker, yo) sm, k1, sm, (yo, knit to marker, yo), k3

Row 2-(WS) K3, purl to marker, sm, p1, sm, purl to next marker, k3

Repeat Row 1 &2 until 33 stitches on needle, then work Row 1 once more (37 sts)

#### **Garter Section A: (Always worked in MC)**

Row 1-(WS) knit all stitches, sm markers as they appear Row 2-(RS) K3, (yo, knit to marker, yo), sm, k1, sm, (yo, knit to marker, yo), K3 Row 3-(WS) knit all stitches, sm markers as they appear 41 stitches on needle

# Lace Section: (Always worked in CC)

Row 1-(RS) K3, (k2tog, yo) rep. until 1 st before the marker, yo, k1, yo, sm, K1, sm, yo, k1, yo, (ssk, yo) repeat until 3 sts remain, K3
Row 2-(WS) K3, purl to last 3 sts, K3
69 stitches on needle

# **Garter Section B: (Always worked in MC)**

Row 1-(RS) K3, (yo, knit to marker, yo), sm, k1, sm, (yo, knit to marker, yo), K3 Row 2-(WS) knit all stitches, sm markers as they appear Row 3-(RS) K3, (yo, knit to marker, yo), sm, k1, sm, (yo, knit to marker, yo), K3 Row 4-(WS) knit all stitches, sm markers as they appear 77 stitches on needle

Repeat Stockinette Section (Always worked in MC) until 97 sts.

Repeat Garter Section A (Always worked in MC) until 101 sts.

Repeat Lace Section (Always worked in CC) until 125 sts.

Repeat Garter Section B (Always worked in MC) until 133 sts.

Repeat Stockinette Section (Always worked in MC) until 157 sts.

Repeat Garter Section A (Always worked in MC) until 161 sts.

Repeat Lace Section (Always worked in CC) until 185 sts.

Repeat Garter Section B (Always worked in MC) until 193 sts.

Repeat Stockinette Section (Always worked in MC) until 213 sts.

Repeat Garter Section A (Always worked in MC) until 217 sts.

Repeat Lace Section (Always worked in CC) until 241 sts.

Repeat Garter Section B (Always worked in MC) until 249 sts.

# **Begin EDGING:**

With MC - Work Row 1 & 2 of stockinette section 253 sts.

# With CC

Row 1-(RS) K3, (yo, knit to marker, yo), sm, k1, sm, (yo, knit to marker, yo), K3 Row 2-(WS) knit all stitches, sm markers as they appear

# With MC

Row 3-(RS) K3, (k2tog, yo) rep. until 1 st before the marker, yo, k1, yo, sm, K1, sm, yo, k1, yo, (k2tog, yo) repeat until 3 sts remain, K3
Row 4-(WS) K3, purl to last 3 sts, K3

Repeat these 4 rows two more times (note, if your tension is a bit looser you may only be able to repeat once)

Then repeat Rows 1-2

With MC Bind off all stitches as loosely as you can (if you tend to bind off tightly, try going up a full needle size)

Block and weave in ends.
