## Clue #13

A quick recap, so we have lots of snails all rolled up, snug and ready for the next phase of this project. So far, you have knit thousands of stitches, thousands of inches, and we almost coming to the end...

At this point we have a decision to make. We can add one more section (I think we should roll the dice and do that, but you can choose...remember this is supposed to stay stress free)

With colour #10 cast on 45 stitches.

Row 1-10 work in stockinette stitch, break yarn

Row 11-50, With colour #15 work 2 rows stockinette stitch, attach colour #20 and work 2 rows in stockinette stitch, repeat these 4 rows 9 more times, break both yarns.

Row 51-60 With Colour #17, work in stockinette stitch, break yarn

Row 61-70 With Colour #18, work in stockinette stitch, break yarn

Row 71-94 With Colour #19, work 4 rows in stockinette stitch, attach Colour #13, work 4 rows in stockinette stitch, repeat these 8 rows 2 more times, break both yarns.

Row 95-155, (use two colours that you have the most of), work 2 rows in stockinette stitch, attach second colour, and work 2 rows in stockinette stitch, rep these 4 row s 14 more times.

We are aiming for a watch party at approx. 7:30 EST Tuesday, April 28, tomorrow evening to learn mattress stitch. (As long as my wifi is holding strong, we should be good to go) we will also post an extra clue sometime this week We will record a video and post the link for those who can't watch when we go live.
