# Glass Wall Art Mounting Guide

Only one set of plates must be used per glass Wall Art. Both plates should be mounted evenly on the reverse side of the Wall Art. Uneven load distribution can occur when three or more plates are mounted. This may lead to the overload or even the detachment of individual plates. Before you begin, determine whether your wall is masonry or hollow, as this will affect the depth of drilling and the type of mounting that is appropriate. Drilling near wires and pipes should be avoided.

### PREPARE FOR MOUNTING

Decide where to place your Wall Art and mark with a pencil. You may want to use a levelling tool for accuracy.

## CLEAN AND PREPARE THE SURFACE

Ensure the wall is clean and free from dust and dirt. Spray glass cleaner onto the reverse side of the Wall Art and wipe with a paper towel

# MARK PLACEMENTS FOR THE PLATES

With a pencil, mark the position of the plates on the reverse side of the Wall Art. Both plates should be 10cm away from the upper and lateral edges.

### FIX PLATES TO WALL ART

Remove the protective backing and place plates evenly applying pressure to the reverse side of the Wall Art. Leave to rest at room temperature for 30 minutes. The plates cannot be moved once they have been bonded.

#### MARK DRILL HOLES ON WALL

Mark the location of your drill holes on the chosen area of your wall with a pencil. Be sure to match these up accurately with the Wall Art plates.

# DRILL HOLES INTO WALL

Depending on your wall type, drill holes evenly ready for wall plugs.

### INSERT WALL PLUGS

Once you are satisfied with drill holes, insert wall plugs, thread discs onto screws, and secure them close to the wall. Make sure to leave a space for mounting plates.

## APPLY PROTECTIVE PADDING

To avoid damage, peel off the backing and place protective square pads near the base of the Wall Art.

### MOUNTING OF WALL ART

After plates have rested for 30 minutes, press once again firmly to the Wall Art and then hang onto the discs. By tuning the discs, the height can be adjusted to horizontally position the Wall Art.
