PRECAUTIONS AND RE-ENTRY PERIOD:

DO NOT spray directly on humans, pets or animals. Avoid contact with food, food utensils or preparation surfaces.

Re-entry Period

Post Construction, Vector Control and Urban Pest Management. Allow treated areas to completely dry (normally 3-4 hours) and ventilate buildings before re-occupying. Worker re-entry to treated areas should be restricted until the spray has dried. When prior entry is necessary wear cotton overalls, over normal clothing, buttoned to the neck and wrist, elbow-length PVC, neoprene or nitrile gloves and chemical resistant footware. Clothing must be laundered after each day's use

STORAGE, SPILLAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Store in closed original containers, in a cool, well ventilated area away from children, animals, food and feedstuffs. Do not store for prolonged periods in direct sunlight.

In case of spillage, confine and absorb spilled product with absorbent material such as sand, clay or cat litter. Dispose of waste as indicated below or according to the Australian Standard AS 2507 - Storage and Handling of Pesticides. Do NOT allow spilled product to enter sewers, drains, creeks or any other waterways.

Triple or preferably pressure rinse containers before disposal. Add rinsings to spray tank. Do not dispose of undiluted chemicals on site. If recycling, replace cap and return clean containers to recycler or designated collection point.

If not recycling, break, crush or puncture and bury empty containers in a local authority landfill. If no landfill is available, bury the containers below 500 mm in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose clear of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots. Empty containers and product should not be burn!

Do not bury waste or surplus product. Dispose of undilluted waste either by dilution and use according to the Directions for Use table or returning to the point of purchase in the original container for controlled disposal. Dispose of diluted surplus product by using according to the Directions for Use table. Do not re-use empty container.

SAFETY DIRECTIONS:

When using prepared spray wear protective waterproof clothing, gloves and water resistant footwear. After each day's use, wash gloves and contaminated clothino. Wash hands after use.
