Hunt Slonem, is an internationally recognized American painter, sculptor, and printmaker. Slonem is renowned for his distinct neo-expressionist style and is best known for his series of bunnies, butterflies, and tropical birds, as well as his large-scale sculptures. Since his first solo show at the Fischbach Gallery in 1977. Slonem's work has been showcased internationally hundreds of times, most recently at the Moscow Museum of Modern Art and the State Russian Museum in St. Petersburg. Slonem's works can be found in the permanent collections of 250 museums around the world, including the Metropolitan Museum of Art, the Whitney, and the New Orleans Museum of Art. In addition. Hunt has received numerous honors, including a MacDowell Fellowship and National Endowment for the Arts grant. He splits his time between New York City, Pennsylvania, and Louisiana.

Christopher Makos burst onto the photography scene in 1977 with White Trash Uncut. As a prominent figure in the New York downtown art scene of the 1970s and 1980s, Makos chronicled the downtown NYC punk scene, befriending and capturing raw, indelible portraits of the likes of Andy Warhol, Roy Lichtenstein, Patti Smith, and Keith Haring.

Born in Lowell, MA, he grew up in California and went on to study architecture in Paris, briefly working as an apprentice for the famed Surrealist photographer Man Ray. His photographs have been exhibited in galleries and museums such as the Guggenheim Museum in Bilbao, the Tate Modern in London, the Whitney Museum of American Art in New York, the IVAM in Valencia (Spain), and the Reina Sofia

Museum in Madrid. And his pictures have appeared in magazines and newspapers, including *Paris Match*, *Interview*, and the *Wall Street Journal*. He continues to live and work in New York, NY.
