# Dear Friends,

My name is Jedidiah (Jed) Templin. I am Mrs. Hanes' oldest grandchild. My entire life has revolved around the cookie business. My mom, Mona, ran the business for over 40 years. From the very beginning, I have been a part of the business. I was the first official "Cookie taster." When I was around 7 years of age I was waiting on customers and putting together Moravian Stars for people. At 8 years of age, I began doing the radio commercials that my mom wrote for me. I must have sounded really cute because people still come into the bakery today and quote some of them: "You make the best cookies in the world Grandma. Just ask the Jedman."

I was so proud.

To this day, I remain proud.

I am now 38 years old and President of our family business.

I have personally experienced many of the challenges and changes. My mom (Mona) was President for 42 years and all the family would help out during our busy holiday season. I watched her go from handwritten UPS labels and a handwritten billing manifest-(yes, we used to handwrite every shipping address in a book using carbon paper) to "going on" computer in 1989. The "dial up" computer enabled us to type in addresses so we could generate a printed UPS billing manifest. Printing that manifest would sometimes take up to 10 hours to print on a busy shipping day. We started accepting credit cards in 1993, then in 1998, we added a website so people could order online. In 1999 we were able to add barcodes to our shipping labels so we could use a tracking system.

Well, you get it, I have seen it all. We are a 4th generation family business. There are not a lot of those around and there is a reason for that. It's not easy! There are the personal differences. My mom, Mona, and my Uncle Mike were "in charge" for those 40 plus years. Now, not only are they brother and sister, but they are also as different as night and day. Let





me tell you, that has made for some very "interesting" family dinners and office dynamics. (My mom used to joke that the office help might want to purchase combat insurance.) However those differences ultimately resulted in balance, and despite their occasional disagreements, those arguments were always tempered by the deep love and respect they held for their mom and my grandmother, Mrs. Hanes.

No one ever wanted to hurt or disappoint her. As her grandson, I always felt the same.

I am writing the family letter this year, because my amazing grandma, Mrs. Hanes, passed away June 22, 2023. (I've included her obituary on page 6.)

As the current 4th generation, (and 8th generation Moravian) I am honored to serve as the President of our family business and to continue our handmade cookie tradition. My Grandpa Travis, my mom and my Uncle

# Evva Foltz Hanes Nov 7, 1932 - June 22 2023

Evva Foltz Hanes was born November 7, 1932. She was the 7th of seven children born to Alva Foltz and Bertha Crouch Foltz. She died peacefully at home, June 22, 2023, surrounded by 4 generations of her loving family.

She was a red-headed, freckled face, shy and observant child. Always watching and learning.

She loved reading and as a mother, shared that love with her children and her grandchildren. She believed that one of the best gifts you can give a child is the joy of reading.

She was an athlete. A STAR basketball player at Arcadia School in Davidson County, NC. After graduating high school, she was "recruited" to play basketball and work for Hanes Hosiery. She always did her best at any job and on "piece work" she eventually earned more than her supervisor.

The value of hard work was also a gift she instilled in her children.

She had simple dreams. One of those dreams was to marry her childhood sweetheart, Travis Flay Hanes. They met in the 8th grade, and it was a true and lasting love. They were partners in life AND in business. Together, they began Mrs. Hanes' Handmade Moravian Cookies. This was not an easy task for a woman in the 1950s. In the beginning, Evva helped her mother make these special cookies in a woodstove. Later, she made like any family, we have our disagreements them in an upstairs kitchen at her house. Then, (because everyone got tired of smelling like a cookie), a downstairs kitchen was added. Then the den downstairs became a kitchen. (All of this was federally, and state inspected.) The entire family was involved in the cookie making business. We (the children) mixed up dough (by hand), helped "man" the ovens and packed the cookies into red tins for shipping. (Exactly the way we continue to pack them today.)

Finally, in 1969, a building was constructed on the family farm, on a section where her daddy's old cow pasture used to be. Since its original construction, the building has been expanded seven times to accommodate the increase in business.

It is a company that is now nationally known. Her bakery has been written about in numerous magazines and newspapers and has thousands of loyal local and mail order customers. A decision was made many years ago to maintain the integrity of her Moravian heritage and continue to make her special cookies by hand. This is a crazy way to run a business in today's machine-oriented world, but changing the method of manufacturing, (and we did try) would change the recipe and alter the taste too much. So, while other companies opted to go the machine route, this lady decided to stay true to her roots and continue her handmade method.

Our mom knew she didn't want to be the biggest Moravian Cookie Company, (making the most money), she just wanted to be the

best. And that is the legacy she passed down to her children, and to her grandchildren who have continued the business.

She has written two cookbooks and recently, at the age of 90, completed a book about her life, called; "What more could I ask for?

She was a 7th generation Moravian and truly loved her church and God. She was very active at Friedberg Moravian Church and served on numerous Boards. If something needed organizing, she was the one to ask. She could always see the fastest, and smartest way to accomplish any goal.

To sum it all up, our mom was brilliant. A woman who succeeded because she worked so very hard to make her dreams come true. As I said earlier, her dreams were simple: She wanted to marry our dad and live in a nice brick house.

They were married 71 years and lived happily in that brick house. Eventually they redid the house she was born in and made that a gathering place for her weekly dinners. She had a special dinner table commissioned that could comfortably accommodate 23 people. Around that table, much laughter was heard, stories were shared, and wonderful memories were made.

We were so very blessed to have her in our life. She showed us how to love and be a family. Sure, (especially when you combine this with being a family business). But bottom line, we really do love each other and enjoy each other's company. I'd say, that was the best gift of all.

Surviving is her husband of 71 years, Travis Flay Hanes and 4 children. Ramona Hanes Templin (Scott), Michael Hanes, Jonathan Hanes (Sheila), & Caroline Hanes Fordham (Norian). Grandchildren; Jedidiah Hanes Templin (Lori), Madison Hanes Boland (Jim), Isabella and Fiona Hanes, and Evva Kate, Lucy, and Norian Fordham. Great grandchildren; (Our future Cookie Tasters) Hanes and Georgia Boland and Adelaide Templin.

A "Going home" celebration will be held Saturday, July 29 at 3 p.m. at Friedberg Moravian Church. Visitation with the family will be held prior to the service from 1:30 to 2:45 p.m. in the Family Life Center. There will be no funeral home visitation as our mom donated her body to research in hopes her struggle with breast and brain cancer will one day help lead

# Mrs. Hanes' Story

"I remember as a child Iving beneath my mother's old wood stove as she baked Moravian cookies. The craft of making cookies was brought from Germany by the early Moravian settlers.

At age 5, I began helping my mother (Bertha Crouch Foltz) make the cookies at Christmas to supplement the family income received from our small dairy farm. In 1960, my mother's health failed, and I took over the baking, By word of mouth the business grew and the reputation of our unique, thin, high quality cookies has spread around the world. Now we have over 90.000 mail-order customers!"

While business has grown steadily, our method of making the cookies remains the same. Every cookie is rolled, cut and packed by hand. The flavor is literally rolled into the cookie.

Our first product was the Moravian Sugar Crisps Cookie. This old family recipe has been handed down for generations. Our customers say, "It is truly a cookie with a personality." We also make Moravian Ginger Crisps. This type of gingerbread cookie has been a local Christmas favorite. It is rolled paper thin and is delicious! In addition, we also make Lemon Crisps, Chocolate Crisps, Butterscotch Crisps and Black Walnut Crisps. Every flavor is special and unique. You really are buying an honest-to-goodness, oldfashioned cookie.

Our business is a family endeavor. Mrs. Evva Foltz Hanes was the seventh generation of Moravian cookie makers. Evva and Travis and were followed in the business by daughter, Ramona Hanes Templin and son, Mike Hanes.

Grandson Jedidiah Templin joined in 2018 and is now President. Our grandchildren are the ninth generation.

All of the younger grandchildren have the formidable job of being "Cookie Tasters". Being a family business, our pride in our product is personal as is the concern and care we give each order. Because of this concern, quality service is maintained.

We emphasize the name. Mrs. Hanes in all our advertising. The reason for this is because not every Moravian cookie is created equally. Some Moravian cookies are now being made by machine. But, not Mrs. Hanes' Moravian Cookies! We honestly create hand-made cookies. This means all dough is hand-rolled **by a person**. Each cookie is hand-cut **by a** person. Every tin, tube or bag is handpacked by a person!

Yes, "made by hand" is expensive and labor intensive. While machines would certainly increase our profit margin, we'd also have to make our dough "machine friendly." This would dramatically alter the taste and quality of our cookies. That's not something we are willing to do, nor is it the cookie Mrs. Hanes wants to represent. Our goal is not to be the biggest, most profitable cookie company in the world, we simply want to be the best.

So look for the name, Mrs. Hanes, and her picture on any Moravian Cookies that you buy. If you see that name, you can be assured that you are buying a real Moravian cookie!

Now, over 30 years later, news of our bakery tours has spread far and wide. Last year over 8,000 school children and over 6,000 senior citizens, local and national tour groups visited our bakery."

# **Tour Specifics**

A typical tour lasts around one hour and every tour is a personally customized experience. In school tours, we incorporate mathematics, economics, writing and history. We visit "Grandma's Kitchen" (equipped with a wood stove, an antique cupboard and table, rolling pin, cookie cutters and pans). # What is a Moravian?

"What exactly is a Moravian?" This is a question we are often asked. Originating in the Czech province of Moravia, the Moravian church was a pre-Reformation church begun by John Hus of Bohemia. His protest and teachings caused him to die a martyr's death at the stake on July 6, 1415.

The followers of John Hus organized the Unitas Fratrum (Unity of the Brethren) which became the first fully organized Protestant church in 1457. Many members were persecuted, driven from their homes and imprisoned.

They migrated to Germany and found refuge on the estate of a young nobleman, Count Zinzendorf, who was interested in their beliefs. They were often referred to as "that religious group from Moravia", and thus the name "Moravia" evolved.

The Moravians came to America and established a settlement in Bethlehem, PA. From there they came south to what is now Winston-Salem, NC. Today there are many Moravian churches in our area.

Our bakery is located on Friedberg Church Road. The road received its name from Friedberg Moravian Church built in 1779 and where nine generations of my family have been members since the beginning.

# **Our Artists In Aprons**

They don't **manufacture** cookies they **create** them. At 6:30 am, Monday through Friday, about forty-five employees arrive and start their work day. Rolling pins in hand, they begin the painstaking process of making these delicate cookies. It's not an easy task. The cookies are so fragile and thin that each 14 ounce bag or tin contains close to 90 cookies. We often hear customers refer to our cookies as "works of art". They get no argument from us!

We make around 100,000 pounds of cookies a year and there are at least 100 cookies in a pound. That equals **ten million cookies**, each cut out **one by one using only a cookie cutter**. That is quite a feat!

For those of you who live near our bakery, we encourage you to take a drive into the country and visit us. Our bakery sits in the middle of what was once my great grandfather's farm. All year long our bakery is a flurry of activity. Our "Artists in Aprons" are always busy at work.
