Thank you for purchasing our proximity marker with a 50 ft. measuring tape. We wanted to give you a little information on the proper care of this product to minimize any reorder cost to you.

First, please use caution when unpacking and when storing these proximity markers. They are powder coated aluminum, so they will not rust but do require proper care. Please let your staff know to avoid throwing, tossing, or abusing the proximity marker, especially on hard surfaces. The unit is used by placing it in the cup and sits on the edge of the green between uses.

The vinyl sheet that comes with the proximity marker can be written on with sharpie, pen, or pencil. Each vinyl sheet is meant for single time use before peeling off and replacing with a new sheet for your next event.

Vinyl Application:

- 1) Wipe flat side of proximity marker surface with alcohol
- 2) Carefully peel off vinyl sheet from the corner
- 3) While holding opposite corners of the sheet, place the sheet lightly in position most suitable
- 4) After vinyl sheet is in place, use thumbs to secure onto proximity marker while removing bubbles working from the middle to the outside.

*If a bubble forms, lightly poke a hole to release the air with a pin
