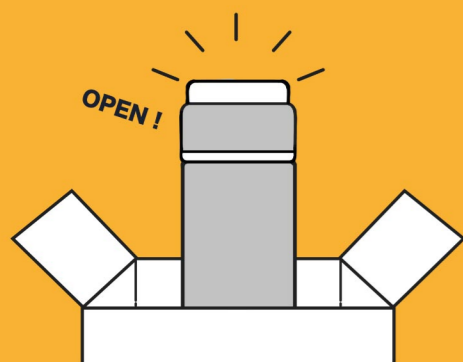



## TEASY PARTS:

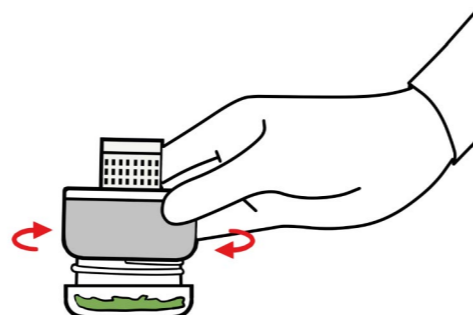
-  — HIGH BOROSILICATE GLASS CONTAINER
-  — RING & REMOVABLE SEAL (FOOD-GRADE SILICONE)
-  — REMOVABLE TEA FILTER (STAINLESS STEEL)
-  — INSULATED FLASK (STAINLESS STEEL)

## 1 PLACE TEA LEAVES IN GLASS CONTAINER



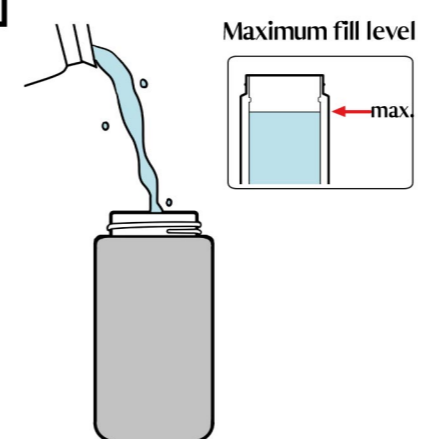
**CAUTION:** OVERFILLING OR PROTRUDING TEA LEAVES MAY CAUSE SPILL

## 2 TIGHTEN THE RING ONTO GLASS CONTAINER



**CAUTION:** FASTEN TIGHTLY WITH NO LEAF TRAPPED ON THE RIM TO PREVENT SPILL

## 3 FILL FLASK WITH WATER



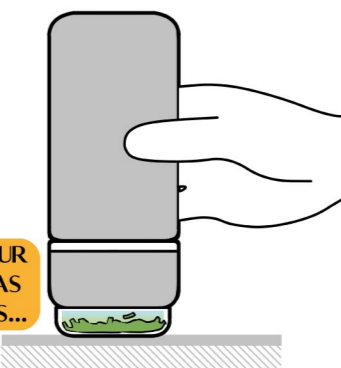
**CAUTION:** OVERFILLING MAY CAUSE SPILL

## 4 TIGHTEN THE RING ONTO FLASK



## 5 INVERT FLASK TO INFUSE

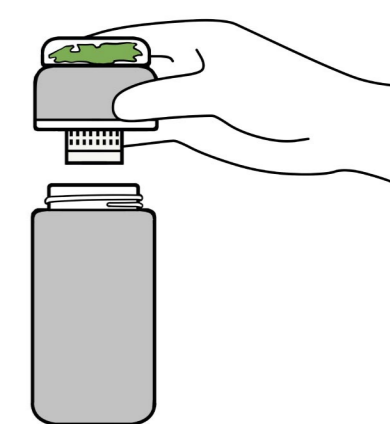
**WATCH COLOUR CHANGES AS IT INFUSES...**



STOP INFUSION BY FLIPPING OVER FLASK

## 6 TWIST OPEN THE RING

**CAUTION:** HOT GLASS



LET ANY REMAINING LIQUID TO DRIP DOWN

## 7 ENJOY YOUR INFUSION

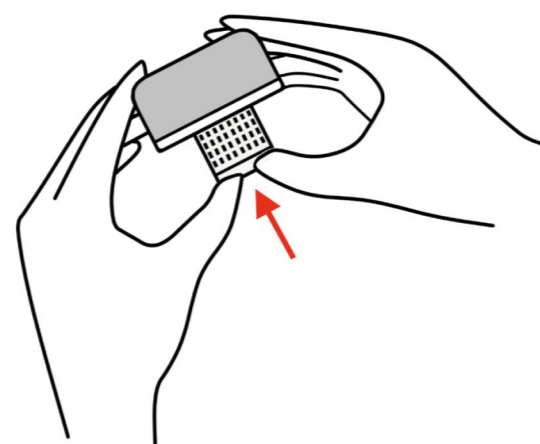


**CAUTION:** HOT CONTENT. WAIT FOR IT TO COOL SUFFICIENTLY BEFORE SIPPING

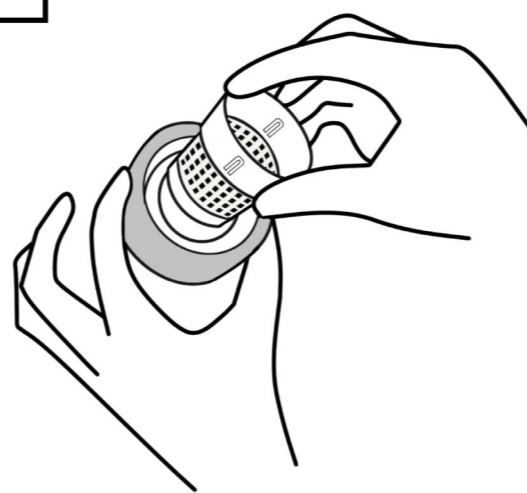
## DETACH & ATTACH TEA FILTER :

- TO REMOVE TEA FILTER, SIMPLY PUSH BOTTOM OF FILTER UPWARDS (SEE FIG. D)
- TO REFIT TEA FILTER, FIRST PLACE TEA FILTER INSIDE THE RING (SEE FIG. A1)
- THEN, PRESS DOWN FILTER INTO THE CORRECT POSITION (SEE FIG. A2)
- FINALLY, TWIST BOTH TEA FILTER AND THE RING IN OPPOSITE DIRECTIONS (SEE FIG. A3)
- MAKING SURE TEA FILTER AND SILICONE SEAL ARE CORRECTLY ALIGNED (SEE FIG. A4)

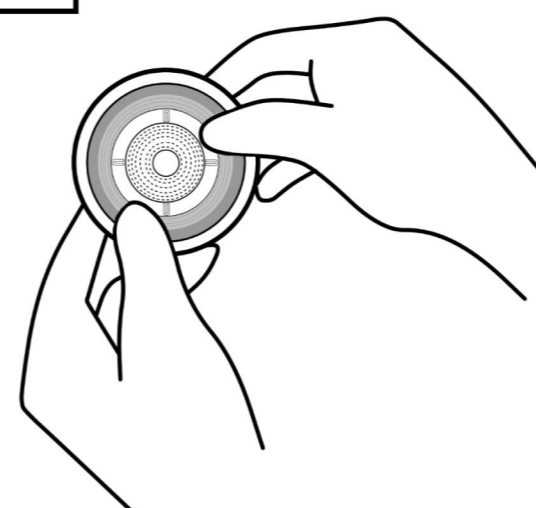
## D PUSH UP TO REMOVE FILTER



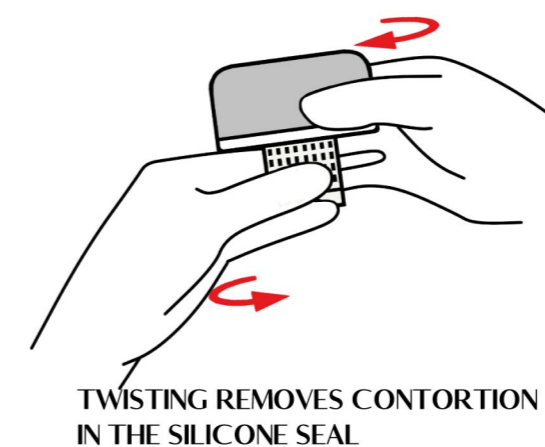
## A1 PLACE FILTER INSIDE RING



## A2 PRESS DOWN FILTER

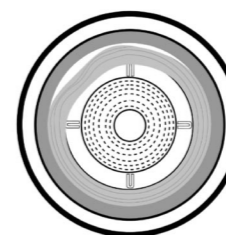


## A3 TWIST RING & TEA FILTER IN OPPOSITE DIRECTIONS

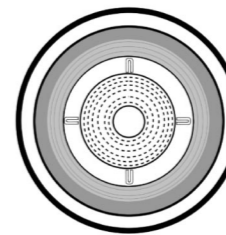


TWISTING REMOVES CONTORTION IN THE SILICONE SEAL
