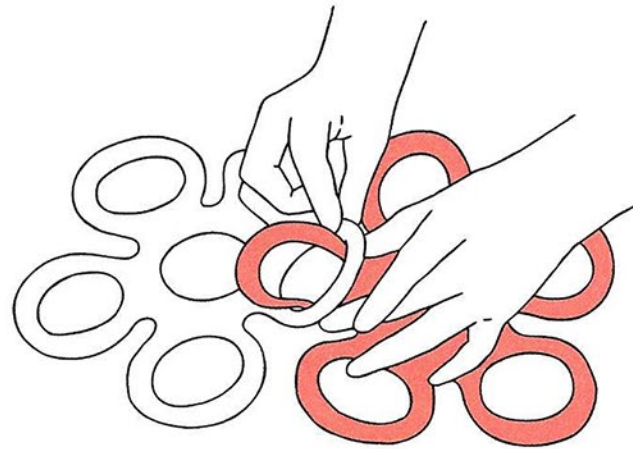


Loopy Lu

Assembly Instructions

The loopy lu petals can be joined together by squeezing one flexible plastic loop through the hole of the other petal as in the picture (right). If you imagine the central petal to be grey this is exactly the 1st movement you will make when starting to attach the outer petals displayed in red.



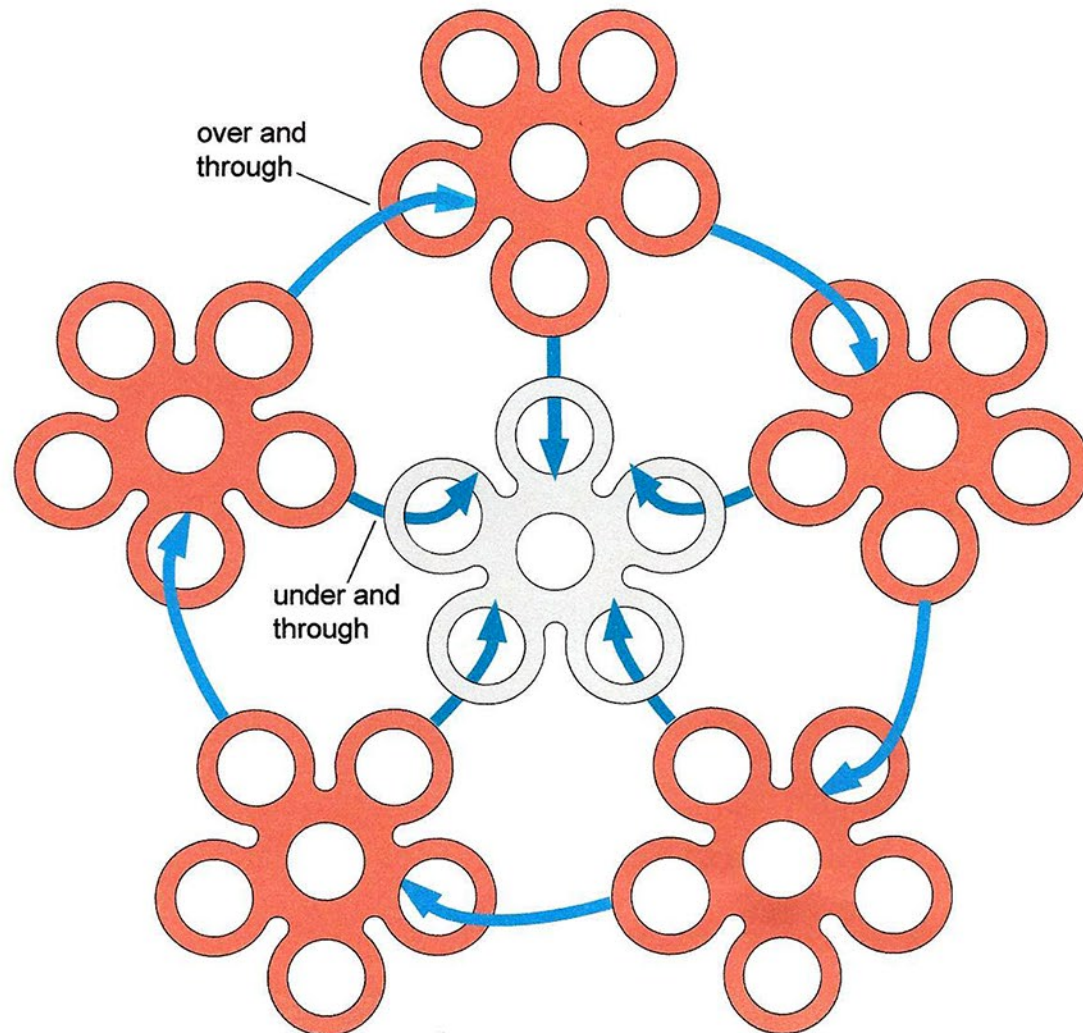
Step 2.

In this picture the piece in red is what you should have made. Please check that the centre loops (red) are overlapping the centre hole of the centre panel (grey) which is important to create the iris which the lamp fitting will hang on later. If you have not achieved this you need to go back and check previous step.

Now add each of the remaining 5 petals to your bowl structure by attaching all pairs of loops shown with the arrows closest to the centre. Finally attach loops around the outside of diagram to complete the loopy lu. Great now time to hang it up!

Step 1.

Start attaching petals as in the diagram below attaching all the central loops first before the outer loops and paying special attention to whether the arrows direct the loops under or over and through the holes. As you attach the outside arrows the structure should start to curve up into a bowl shape. If you have made an upside down bowl structure this is wrong and you will need push the middle down to flip it though.



Important! The 5 central arrows loop under and through as opposed to all other steps.
