


WATCH STRAP SIZE GUIDE

To ensure the perfect measurement of your strap and wrist, please make sure that the option "scale to fit paper size" is not selected in your printer's settings. You can also

- Use a tape measure. please make sure to use the metric scale (mm).
- Use a piece of string, measure your wrist using a piece of string, then determine its length with a ruler using the metric scale (mm).

THE OPPOSITE SAMPLE
MUST EXACTLY MEASURE 2CM



WHAT TO DO

- 1 Cut out the length measuring aid along the lines. Cut a slit on the dotted line.
- **2** Make sure that the numbers increments are facing outwards. Insert the pointed end of the band through the slit. Slide your hand into the strap and pull on the pointed end until it sits on your wrist as your watch would.
- **3** The number appearing along the edges of the slit opening is your desired wrist size.


LENGTH MEASUREMENT

Put the shorter section of the strap (located at 12), then the longer section of the strap (located at 6) on the measuring guide. The side attached to the box must be placed along the blue line.


WIDTH MEASUREMENT

Use the sides of the ruler to measure the width of the watch strap and the watch lug.
