

MAKE YOUR MARK

INSTRUCTIONS

- I. Cut clutch exterior out of leather using rotary cutter.
- 2. Glue or weld rough side of leather to 2/3 oz. veg-tan leather on the rough side.
- 3. Allow to dry, then cut off excess lining.
- 4. Dye veg-tan lining with chocolate dye.
- 5. Seal with Eco-Flo[®] Super Sheene and allow to dry.
- 6. Sew exterior and lining together with a 1/4" seam allowance.
- 7. Sand and burnish, then apply Edge Flex to edges and allow to dry.
- Fold bottom edge to the top of the flap (should measure 6.5" when folded) to form clutch and clamp edges together. Let sit for about 30 minutes to create a form.
- 9. Unclamp sides to install Kora clasp to clutch.
- 10. Place 1/2" D-ring in center and fold to create housing to attach wristlet strap to later.
- II. Place D-ring housing in position marked on pattern.
- 12. Re-clamp sides together and close Kora clasp.
- 13. Measure and punch holes for rivets on each side of clutch using rotary punch. Be sure to place first rivet in center of D-ring housing.
- 14. Install medium double-cap rivets using rivet setter.
- 15. Using Kodiak leather cut one $15^{\circ} \times 0.5^{\circ}$ strip.
- 16. Skive ends of strip.
- 17. Set with rivet onto D-ring.
- 18. Burnish edges to create a clean finish.
