STAMPED EARRINGS

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Cut a small piece of tooling leather about 4" x 4" square.
- Using your tracing pattern and film, trace the pattern onto the film with a pencil.
 Optional: Leave extra space around edges and tape to leather to prevent movement.
- 3. Wet leather with sponge and let dry briefly. While still damp, trace pattern onto leather.
- 4. Remove tracing film and cut pattern out with craft knife.
- 5. Use rotary punch to create a small hole in the leather at the top each earring for hardware.
- 6. Use edge beveler to finish edges of earrings.
- 7. Before stamping, case leather with water.
- 8. Stamp patterns into leather while still damp with stamps of your choice, using a larger stamp for middle of earrings. Allow leather to dry completely.
- 9. Use wool dauber to apply dye in a circular motion until earrings are dyed evenly on front and back. Allow to dry completely.
- 10. Use wood dauber to dye edges of earrings. Allow to dry for a minute and burnish edges.
- 11. Optional: Apply antique stain in a circular motion with wool dauber.
- 12. Buff earrings with clean rag and apply hardware.
