



Prince Madog Joan Dane





The Green Graves of Balgowrie Jane Helen Findlater





JANE HELEN FINDLATER (1866–1946) was a celebrated novelist and short-story writer, sometimes in collaboration with her elder sister Mary. Her first novel, *The Green Graves of Balgonnie* (1896), was a great success. She became known for her authentic portrayals of rural life in Scotland, and was admired by contemporaries such as Rudyard Kipling and Virginia Woolf. Her work has subsequently gone out of print and fallen into relative obscurity.




A whimsical and poetic tale of a packman and his donkey journeying through Utopia.



Banned by the Nazis, this haunting novel by a gay German writer in the 1930s is a rare early work of magic realism. This poignant novel, beautifully translated by Simon Beattie, was, in Lampe's words, born into a regime where it could not breathe; he hoped that one day it might rise again. Its depiction of raw reality was unacceptable to the Nazis: the book was seized by them in December 1933 and withdrawn from sale.

Alexander Klaus Mann






