HOLIDAY CARD FROM POWERPOINT

INSTRUCTIONAL HANDOUT FOR THE HOW-TO VIDEO AT BEAGLEFX.COM

BEFORE WE START

These instructions are based on Microsoft PowerPoint version 16 on Mac. Some features may differ on your version.

Beagle FX recommends setting aside 6 - 8 photos to be placed in your design.

GETTING STARTED

- 1) File > New Presentation
- 2) Home > New Slide > Blank Slide
- 3) > View
 - a. Check or uncheck Ruler or Guides.
 - b. Personal preference. We like using them to help place shapes and text.
- 4) Design > Slide Size > Page Set Up
 - a. Choose the dimensions for the paper you want to print.
- 5) Design > Format Background
 - a. Choose a color, pattern, or image you like.
 - b. We like a gradient because it adds a perceived change in light.

START DESIGNING

- 6) Insert > Shapes > Triangle
 - a. Right Click > Format Shape
 - i. Paint Bucket (Fill & Line)
 - 1. Fill of Choice
 - a. We like the no fill option to focus on the photos we'll add as ornaments.
 - 2. Line of Choice
 - 3. Line width recommendation 8 pts
 - ii. Pentagon (Effects)
 - 1. Shadow
 - a. Because it adds depth.
 - b. We recommend 16 pts for the distance because it is easy to remember at double the line width.
 - c. We also like a 45° angle for shadows add depth.
- 7) Insert > Shapes > Cubes and a Can as Presents under the "Tree"

- a. Format Shape > Fill = Picture
- b. Format Shape > Line
 - i. Your choice for Color and Types
- c. Format Shape > Effects > Shadow
 - i. Recommended angle 45°
 - ii. Recommended distance is double the line width of your presents.
- d. Click the shapes and drag the transformation points and lines to reshape where the picture is inserted and how the present's lines look
- 8) Insert > Shapes > Curved up or Curved down ribbons for presents
- 9) Fancier bow
 - a. Insert > Shapes > Wave
 - i. Add one and change color and line to liking, then
 - 1. Copy and paste.
 - 2. Flip horizontal and vertical.
 - b. Insert > Shapes > Plaque with same formatting on top the two waves
- 10) Shadow tip:
 - a. Select all ribbon shapes with CMD (MAC) or CTRL (PC) click
 - i. Add a shadow to your liking.
- 11) Insert > Shapes > Ovals as Traditional "Glass" Ball Ornaments
 - a. Format Shape > Line
 - i. Your choice for Color and Types
 - b. Format Shape > Fill = Picture

ADD THE GARNISH TO YOUR DESIGN

- 1) Insert > Shapes > Add Scroll
 - a. Change colors and shadows.
 - b. Word Art for Label
- 2) Insert > Shapes > Wave or Double Wave for garland
 - a. Change color
