Salāmun 'alaykum,

Alḥamdulilāh this year was another humbling experience of working with dedicated individuals, organizations, and community leaders. Our global community is working hard, and we are honored to be part of this ummah. May Allah increase in the success of all the Muslim ummah all around the world.

Success is often measured on an individual basis, but as the Noble Qur'ān says in Sūrah Naḥl, each individual can actually be a nation within themselves.

إِنَّ إِبْرُهِيمَ كَانَ أُمَّةً قَاتِتًا لَّهُ حَنِيفًا وَلَمْ يَكُ مِنَ ٱلْمُشْرِكِينَ Indeed Abraham was a nation [all by himself], obedient to Allah, a Hanīf, and he was not a polytheist.

Mālilk al-Ashtar when asked to govern Egypt expressed concern to Imām ʿAlī (ʿa) of being sent so far away from him, and to

a place that was predominantly non-Muslim at the time. Imām asked if Mālik felt that Allah was near or far. To which Mālik responded that indeed Allah is closer than our jugular vein, all we need to do is call on Him. Imām ʿAlī (ʿa) then said that Yā Mālik, if Allah is near, then how can the one who is His mediator and connector be far? In other words, Imām too was close to Mālik, all he had to do was call out Yā ʿAlī!

Mālik was essentially being pushed outside of his comfort zone of Kufah, and away from his beloved to change a nation. We need to do this too and realize our potential and think of how we can impact the global community.

As Muslims, our success cannot be individualistic and our vision cannot be myopic. Our path to success has four levels:

- Bettering ourselves
- Having strong families
- Giving back to our community
- And working towards the global society



We are all connected globally by our faith and our communities are all rooted in the teachings of the Ahl al-Bayt. The mission of RISE Academy is to promote the holistic development of the child through an authentic and experiential student learning experience. This is accomplished by educating the child in the formation of faith, family and community. RISE Academy students learn to become responsible and productive members of the society through a faith-based education promoting tolerance, peace and justice.

R I S E

RISE Institute is a US-based, nationally accredited online school that strives for the development of the whole child by providing excellence in academic preparation in a faith-based environment. This means that in addition to the core subjects of Reading, Writing, Math, Science and Social Studies, we integrate Qur'ān, Islamic Studies, and Mentorship to develop students towards high levels of God-consciousness, professional excellence and civic leadership by serving the larger society around them.

RISE Institute offers a holistic education that incorporates the teachings of the Ahl al-Bayt, where teachers utilize critical thinking that allow students to find creative solutions to real world issues. RISE Institute gives a voice to all students with small class sizes, personalized learning experiences, and leadership opportunities.

MILESTONES

- RISE Institute creates a holistic learning environment through Islamic, academic, enrichment, and social opportunities for every student, through our daily assemblies, after school clubs, school-wide competitions and events, and facilitation in-person gatherings in large cities.

- During the Urwathul Wuthqa Quran Competition RISE Institute competed alongside 11 other registered students from across the globe for the second annual Qur'an Competition. RISE had 4 students placed as finalists, and the school was recognized as one of the two top schools in the competition.
- RISE Institute students showed scholastic and academic success in our school assessments and presentations.
 - In our NWEA MAP Benchmarking Assessment, RISE analyzed the student data and 100% of the classrooms are achieving at or above grade level.
- STREAM Fair: A Celebration of Learning is an annual program where students submit proposals for projects they have done during the year, and present to the school their project, sharing what they learned, and making Islamic connections to their work.
- RISE hosts Student-Led Conferences twice per year to give students the opportunities to share their personal goals with their parents and progress towards those goals. Learning Coaches (parents) shared 100% satisfaction rate that Student-Led Conferences are both beneficial to them and to their learners.

RISE MICROSCHOOLS

RISE MicroSchools are an opportunity for our RISE Institute families to gather on a regular basis to provide the students with religious, social, and academic enrichment. The RISE MicroSchools will be using programs created by the RISE team and in line with the mission and vision of the school. MicroSchools are established in communities of our RISE Institute families who are interested in providing this program for their children.

RISE students can spend time together while sharing their love of learning and the Ahl al-Bayt. RISE MicroSchools located in Islamic centers will encourage students to participate in local programs while enjoying time with their friends. RISE MicroSchools are building blocks for community schools.

- RISE Simi Valley in California started a 5 day a week MicroSchool program that enrolled 6 students from Kindergarten to Grade 2, and will be expanding to 3rd grade next year and 8 students.
- Simi Valley MicroSchools students take their core classes online with RISE Institute teachers and have recess, lunch, extra curricular activities, Islamic celebrations & commemorations with their peers at the in-person facility. MicroSchools are a unique place where students receive the high quality education from credentialed and experienced RISE Institute teachers and enjoy the social aspect of in person schools.
- RISE Seattle in Washington continued their weekly program this year and increased to 15 students enrolled in all grade levels. Currently, there are 20 students enrolled in RISE from the Seattle community for next year. The team also started an early childhood program for children from 2 to 4 years old with 9 students enrolled.
- The Seattle Program starts with Dua Ahad, recitation of the Holy Quran followed by lessons in ELA and Science lessons that incorporate Islamic concepts and hands-on learning. There are also crafts and life skills shortly, followed by salaat and lunch. The final hour is Physical Education where we use the Gym in the facility as well as the children enjoy (weather permitting) the adjoining park.
- RISE Phoenix in Arizona will be launching for the 2023-2024 school year at their local center with currently 11 students enrolled, inshaAllah.
