BASIC FUNCTIONS

These instructions will make it easier for you to handle the device appropriately and help prevent mishaps and possible damage to the device.

Prevent object and liquid entry. Never spill liquid of any kind on the video display and the main body of the unit.

The unit is not shock-resistant. Do not use it as a hammer or drop it.

Do not immerse the camera and monitor in water. Store it in a dry place. Such measures reduce the risk of electric shock and damage. The image head and the cable are water resistant when the unit is fully assembled, but the monitor and camera are not.


Do not use the camera if condensation forms inside the lens. Let the water evaporate before using again.

BATTERY INSTALLATION/REPLACEMENT

Please install the batteries before using the product.

- 1. Remove battery cover and insert 4 new AA (1.5V) batteries.
- Place Batteries into the proper slots in the battery compartment in proper battery orientation as indicated on the battery cover.
- 3. Reinstall battery cover.
- Clean the battery contacts and also those of the device prior to battery installation.
- 5. Remove batteries from equipment which is not to be used for an extended period of time.
- 6. Remove batteries if dead or if product is to be left unused for a long time.



▲ CAUTION

The Borescope should not be exposed to dripping or splashing and that no objects filled with liquids, such as vases. shall be placed on the apparatus.

Turn off the unit if not in use.

Attention should be drawn to the environment aspects of the battery disposal.

Remove the batteries when cleaning the unit.

Remove the batteries before storing the unit for a long time.

When necessary, REPLACE ALL FOUR BATTERIES in the unit with new ones.

Use only the size and type of battery specified.

Be sure to install the battery with the correct polarity as indicated in the battery compartment.

Properly dispose of the battery. Exposure to high temperatures can cause the batteries to explode. Do not dispose in a fire. Tape over the terminals to prevent direct disposal. Please follow all applicable regulations

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

CAMERA PROBE SETUP / STORAGE



STFP 1

Push both buttons to open the camera probe storage compartment.




STEP 2.

Take out the camera probe, unwrap it to its full length and close the compartment.



Turn on the power and ready to inspect!



- ***FOR STORAGE AFTER USE***
- 1. Open the probe storage compartment, follow the track and wrap the probe tidy and neat.
- 2. Close the compartment.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The product is designed as a remote inspection device. It can be used to look into tight spots and show real-time video. Typical applications might include HVAC, termite and other insect or building inspections, cable routing. automotive/boat/aircraft inspections etc.

LIVE MODE (CAMERA/RECORDING)

- 1. Pull backwards on back cover, exposing optical camera cable. Unwind optical camera cable from apparatus.
- 2. Long press power button to turn on/off Borescope.
- 3. To enlarge image long press zoom button repeatedly.
- 4. Press LED Brightness button to adjust LED light.
- 5. Press LCD Brightness button to adjust LCD light.
- 6. To take photo depress snapshot button.
- 7. Long press Monochrome button to change mode.
- 8. Long press Compare Mode button to change mode.
- Press Rotate button to rotate image.

PLAYBACK MODE

- 1. Press menu button to enter playback model
- Select PICTURE or VIDEO folder to view.
- 2. Scroll through pictures/videos using the previous or next arrow buttons, respectively
- 3. To delete picture press menu button followed by the trash can button (Caution: images cannot be undeleted)
- 4. To delete all pictures select the "ALL" option
- 5. To delete a single picture select "CURRENT" option





ACCESSORIES

To attach accessory:

- 1. Position the attachment accessory over the camera head.
- GENTLY screw the attachment accessory clock-wise to the lock the accessory on the camera head.

To detach accessory:

GENTLY screw the attachment accessory counter clock-wise to remove the attachment accessory and store them for future use.



EXPANSION INTERFACE PORTS

Micro USB output for data transfer

This product is equipped with Micro USB port (at its top side) so that you can display or save images/videos to a computer.

- 1. Turn the product off
- 2. Lift up the cover of the USB port and connect the Mirco-USB cable to the USB port.
- Connect the other side of the USB cable to your computer, the product turns on automatically when the computer is on.

HDMI output for display

This product is equipped with Mini HDMI port so that you can display live view on bigger display screen.

1. Connect the Mini HDMI to the product and connect the other side of HDMI cable to your display screen.

Support external Class 10 Mini SD card

This product equipped with Mini SD card slot to support external memory, support Class 10 SD card up to 32G.

CLEANING AND STORAGE

Clean the videoscope housing and the display using only a soft cloth or cotton swab with water or medical alcohol. Do not let any liquid enter the case or sensor area. Allow the lens to fully dry before using the videoscope. Avoid storing the unit in extreme temperature conditions. Do not store below -20°C (-4°F), or where the radiant temperature may exceed 60°C (140°F).

If a defect appears within 12 months after the date of purchase, the purchaser may return the item, together with a purchase receipt or other appropriate proof of purchase to the place of purchase. Upon receipt of the item(s), the place of purchase will, at its option, replace the defective item or refund your money. This warranty shall not apply when the product has been used for commercial or rental purposes, has been tampered with, when repairs or attempted repairs have been made by unauthorized persons, or where the item has been subjected to misuse, abuse, accident or damage in transit. No charges will be accepted for unauthorized parts, repairs or services.

- 1. SUNDAY will, at its sole option, either repair or replace free of charge any new product (including parts) that develops a fault within a period of 12 months starting from the date of shipping with a similar and contemporary product.
