



Cornhole Pong

MANUAL

Intro

Cornhole Pong is a mix of cornhole and beer pong. This is a social game that all ages and skill levels can play.

Setup

1. Remove the two boards from the carry bag.
2. Find a flat, open space to set up the boards 18'-27' apart.
3. Remove all the discs from the holes, revealing 6 open holes on each board.
4. Games can be played with 2 or 4 players.
5. Each team will need two bags. The bags can be 6-in. regulation size or 4-in. junior size (recommended). Both teams should be using the same size bags, delineated by color.
6. Now you are ready to play Elakai Cornhole Pong!

The Playfield

- The recommended distance from the front of board to the front of the other board is 18'-27' depending on your skill level.

The Rules

Game Objective

The objective of the game is to toss bags into each of the six holes before your opponent.

Each team is made up of 1 or 2 players standing next to the same board. Their opponent(s) are standing at the opposite board.

To determine which team starts, players can rely on a coin toss to decide, or each team may toss one bag at the opposing team's board. The team that sinks the first hole starts the game.

Each player on a team tosses one bag at the opposing team's board. Player 1 must complete their toss before player 2 can throw their bag. If playing with 1 player teams, each player will toss 2 bags. Only 1 team may throw bags at one time.

A hole gets closed when a tossed bag goes entirely through the hole. Players cover the hole immediately with the disc.

The game is over when one team has successfully closed every hole on the board.

If a hole that was covered becomes uncovered because of impact during a round, re-cover the hole as it was before that toss.

The other team is allowed one chance for redemption. The losing team must alternate shots and close out the rest of their board without missing a bag.

Overtime consists of the front three holes uncovered and the back three holes covered. The first team to cover the front three holes wins the game. There is no redemption in overtime.

House Rules

Bags Back

If both players successfully sink separate holes in one round, they are rewarded with both bags back and continue to throw.

Death "Cup"

A team automatically wins if their opponent does not immediately close a hole, and the tossing team throws two bags through the same hole in the same round.

House Rules

a. Rules not found in a game's manual

b. Made-up rules followed within one's specific household, party, or event

Care and Maintenance

Keep it Clean

Use a damp cloth to wipe off dust and dirt after every use. If it is a bigger job that requires something more heavy duty, use warm, soapy water. Cleaning your equipment will keep it from deteriorating over time.

Update the Coat

Our games come pre-coated with a high-grade sealant that protects not only the aesthetic of the wood but also, it's integrity. Different climates, weather, and playing surfaces can change the length of the protection you get from our original process, so if you start to see some wear you should simply add another layer of sealer to extend the life of your game. This game is recommended for use on grass or sand.

Mind The Elements

Hail, rain, snow, mud, and heat can damage your game. Protect your game from extreme weather and do not play in harsh conditions.
